LONDON (WNS) One of the repercussions of the political change in Argentina resulting from the removal last June of President Arturo Illia by the military junta has been the "changing of the Argentine Jew from a first to second class citizen," the Financial Times of London disclosed here in a report from its Buenos Aires correspondent.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Former Governor George Wallace of Alabama declared at a Meet the Press TV interview that if he runs for the Presidency in 1968 he will reject the support of George Lincoln Rockwell, founder of the American Nazi Party, or "of anyone who says he is Nazi." The former Governor called himself an old anti-Nazi and an enemy of Nazism.
