Manpower Earnings Up

Manpower, Inc., has re-ported record net earnings and gross revenue for the nine months ended March 31, 1967, Michael Katz, Manager of the Las Vegas Manpower Office announced.

Gross revenues of the international temporary help firm were \$54,751,000 up 25 per cent from \$43,817,000 for the comparable nine Stephen Goot recited the months in the previous fiscal year. Gross revenues consist of branch office sales and franchise fees from licensed offices,

New earnings before taxes rose 18.2 per cent to \$3,-899,000, up from \$3,299,000 for the comparable period in the previous fiscal year.

Net earnings after taxes were \$1,950,000, or \$1.10 per share, up 13.4 per cent from \$1,719,000, or 97¢ per share for the same period in 1966.


