

### Paradise Spa Boom Season

The advent of warm weather in Las Vegas has increased homebuying interest at the Paradise Spa, and general manager Charles Martin is staffing up to handle it.

Martin has expanded the responsibility of sales manager Bob Rohman, who will not be in charge of the health clubs and recreational attractions, in addition to supervising the sales staff.

Such facilities as the Spa's two large swimming pools, tennis court, golf complex, mineral whirlpools and therapeutic baths are becoming increasingly popular with residents of the 400-

home community and visitors as well.

Both Las Vegas residents and out-of-town guests are purchasing resort homes at the Spa, located only three miles from the Strip at 9457 Las Vegas Blvd., South, points out Martin.

With increased use of all facilities at the luxurious development, Martin has appointed Bob Gagg to head the Spa's maintenance staff.

The picturesque lake which winds through the community is now lighted at night by rings of fire and will soon be stocked with rare

fish, according to Gagg.

Tours of the Spa are conducted daily with sales representatives serving as escorts. And, in addition to an "ala carte" program for non-residents in the health clubs, overnight accommodations have been made available for guests.

Homes in the \$40 million development start at \$13,750, including such bonus features as carpeting, drapes and refrigerated air conditioning.

Floor plans range up to 1,200 sq. ft. in one, two and three-bedroom models.

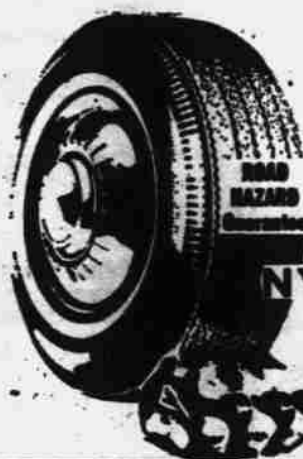
