## Wording of U.N. Resolution

Since there has been recently, references to some aspects of the Armistice Agreement between Israel and Egypt (now the United Arab Republic), attention is drawn to the Security Council Resolution of 1 September 1951, which states:

1. "Since the Armistice regime is of a permanent character, neither party can reasonably assert that it is actively a belligerent or requires to exercise the right of visit, search, and seizure for any legitimate purpose of self-defence;"

2. The Security Council Resolution calls upon Egypt "to terminate the restrictions on the passage of international commercial shipping and goods through the Suez Canal wherever bound."

Nevertheless, the United Arab Republic has continually stated, and continues to assert, that it is in a state of war with Israel. The United Arab Republic by such declarations and deeds thus remains in total defiance of the above resolution of the Security Council.

### AJC Resolution

NEW YORK: The AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE, expressing its alarm over the mounting crisis in the Middle East at the closing session of its 61st Annual Meeting urged the "immediate and unequivocal reaffirmation" of what is called "the fundamental U. S. commitment to Israel" as a matter "of critical importance."

A resolution to this effect, passed at a meeting presided over by Richard Maass of Larchmont, N.Y., Chairman of the AJC's Foreign Affairs Committee, was sent in telegrams to President Johnson and Secretary of State Rusk.

### JWV Statement

WASHINGTON (WNS) Ten years of Communist support of Nasser with arms and propaganda have inflamed the Arab world to the brink of war, it was charged here by the Jewish War Veterans of the U.S.A. in a statement which said that the Soviet Union held the key to peace in the Middle East.

assah's medical facilities "stand ready once more to fulfill their humanitarian tasks in this emergency."

The President's move was also hailed by the present of the Synagogue Council of America, Rabbi Seymour J. Cohen of Chicago. He called the President's declaration "a firm and timely statement."

### JEW'S HAIL LBJ

NEW YORK (WNS) President Johnson's statement on the Middle East crisis was hailed widely here by a number of national Jewish organizations as an act of statesmanship that could serve as a deterrent to Arab bellicosity.

Welcoming President Johnson's declaration on the Middle East crisis, the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations voiced "support of any steps by our Government that may be necessary to resist acts of war against Israel, to protect Israel's national sovereignty and to preserve peace in the Middle East."

Similar views were aired by Mr. Mortimer Jacobson, national president of Hadassah, who voiced "deep gratification" with President Johnson's statement. At the

same time she voiced hope that "the Arab countries will heed President Johnson's appeal to reason and act at once to prevent a conflict in the Middle East which would undermine world peace."

Voicing Hadassah's "deep gratification with President Johnson's forthright declaration reaffirming the United States' firm commitment to preserve the political independence and territorial integrity of all the nations in the Middle East, and its condemnation of any blockade of Israeli shipping the Gulf of Aqaba," Mrs. Jacobson said that "this statesmanlike act on the part of the President should bolster the determination of all peace-loving peoples to mobilize every available resource for the restoration of peace in the Middle East." She simultaneously asserted that Had-
