CAPSULE HISTORY OF THE PAST FEW WEEKS

SYRIAN INFILTRATORS, DESTROYING LIFE AND PROPERTY IN ISRAEL FOR 10 YEARS, COMMENCE LOBBING MORTAR SHELLS OVER THE BORDER, ISRAEL SAYS STOP OR WE'LL TAKE ACTION.

EGYPT CONSTRUES THIS STATEMENT AS AGGRESSION AND BEGINS MASSING ARMY ON ISRAEL BORDER. EGYPT ORDERS UN EMERGENCY FORCE OUT. SEC. GEN. COMPLIES IMMEDIATELY AND WITHOUT CONSULTING SECURITY COUNCIL. ISRAEL MASSESTROOPS TO PROTECT UNGUARDED BORDER. SYRIA, SAUDI ARABIA AND JORDAN AND OTHERS DECLARE ARAB UNITY WITH EGYPT.

EGYPT SEALS OFF GULF OF AQABA, THEREBY BLOCKADING ISRAELI CITY OF EILAT. ISRAEL CLAIMS THIS IS ACT OF AGGRESSION.

UN CALLS SPECIAL SESSION WITH ALL NATIONS ASKING FOR RESTRAINT. COMMY FRANCE ASKS MEET-

ING OF FOUR TOP POWERS, WHICH IS AGREED BY U.S. AND GREAT BRITAIN, BUT BRUSHED BY RUSSIA. EASE TENSION, IS THE PLEA BY MOST NATIONS BUT RUSSIA YAWNS AND SAYS "CONDITIONS ARE NOT THAT BAD."

UN SECY. GEN. RETURNS FROM CAIRO WITH REPORT SITUATION IS VERY SERIOUS, BUT RUSSIA STILL YAWNS, WHILE DENOUNCING ISRAEL AND SUPPORTING EVERY MOVE OF ARABS. U.S. AND BRITAIN ARE DENOUNCED BY ARABS.

SCENES OF MOBILIZATION IN ARAB CAPITOLS, WITH LEADERS STIRRING UP PATRIOTISM IN GUISE OF "HOLY WAR". THREATS ISSUED TO ANNIHILATE ISRAEL AND DRIVE ALL JEWS INTO SEA. ISRAEL CITIES DESERTED, ALL BUSINESS AT HALT, WHILE PLANS ARE BEING MADE FOR DEFENCE.

RENO'S JEWISH COMMUNITY HONORS L.V.'S GREENSPUN

Hank Greenspun, publisher of the Las Vegas Sun, whose devotion to the cause of Israel since its creation is common knowledge, and his dedication to Temple Beth Sholom in Las Vegas, with few peers in our area. is public record, is being honored by the Reno Jewish community.

The Hank Greenspun Humanitarian Award, in recognition of his outstanding contribution to Judaism, is an annual decree given to a person deserving the honor. The Greenspun award consists of two plaques, each with name plates. One plaque hangs permanently in the Reno Temple (Emanu-El). Each year the name of the recipient is inscribed for pos-
