

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK (WNS) Dr. Joseph J. Schwartz, vice president of the Israel Bond Organization, has left for Israel at the invitation of Premier Levi Eshkol to discuss the country's post-war economic needs.

JOHANNESBURG (WNS) A joint statement condemning Arab aggression, coupled with a call for "a just and permanent settlement of the dispute" between Israel and the Arab states, was issued here by three major church groups, Anglican, Methodist and Presbyterian.

NEW YORK (WNS) A statement sharply assailing the Soviet Government for its repeated equating, at the United Nations, of Israel with Nazi Germany was issued here by the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A resolution opposing premature Israeli withdrawal from occupied Arab territories, coupled with support of President Johnson's five-point program for peace in the Middle East, was co-sponsored by 51 members of Congress.

NEW YORK (WNS) The present crisis in the Middle East shows that the various Zionist movements could work even more effectively on the American scene if they were united into one single movement, it was declared here by Hy Faine, president of the Labor Zionist Organization of America--Poale Zion.

NEW YORK (WNS) Premier Levi Eshkol of Israel, in a letter to Dr. Joachim Pinz, chairman of the Conference of Major American Jewish Organizations, voiced "sincere thanks and profound appreciation" to the organization for its expression of "support and encouragement in the crisis through which we have just passed."

NEW YORK (WNS) President Johnson's persistent effort aimed at securing a lasting peace in the Middle East was lauded here by the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America in a statement supporting Mr. Johnson's determination to achieve that aim.

NEW YORK (WNS) The 70th Jubilee convention of the Zionist Organization of America will be held, as scheduled, in Israel from July 19 through 26, it was announced here by ZOA president Jacques Torczyner following lifting of the ban by the State Department on travel to Israel.

DUSELFORF (WNS) Franz Paul Stangle, accused killer of 700,000 Jews in Nazi concentration camps, was brought here for trial from Brazil after losing a series of legal battles he hoped would prevent him from being brought to justice.

No date for the trial has been set. During the war Stangle was commandant of several Nazi concentration camps, among them Sobibor and Treblinka.

LONDON (WNS) Uprooting of tombstones on the Jewish cemetery in the Polish city of Prezemysl was disclosed here in a report from Warsaw which said the police were hunting the hoodlums.

No Anti-Semitism in Russia!

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WNS) The unalterable position taken by Premier Aleksei Kosygin on the Middle East crisis after his talks with President Johnson at Glassboro, indicates that Moscow intends to pursue even a harder line at the forthcoming sessions of the General Assembly.

When the Johnson-Kosygin talks ended there were signs that while the two heads of state held divergent views on Israel, there might be some easing of positions. However, at his press conference at the U.N. the Soviet Premier reiterated, albeit with a lessening of bit-

terness, all of the accusations against Israel that had previously been made by the Soviet Union.

One of the highlights of the press conference was

Mr. Kosygin's denial of the existence of anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union. Kosygin made the assertion in reply to a query, declaring that the question about a new wave of anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union was a trumped up invention by the author of the question. He said Jews in the Soviet Union were enjoying the same rights as other citizens of the country.
