

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

**LONDON (WNS)** Forty Soviet Jews who were granted exit visas to emigrate for reunion with families in Israel have been advised by government authorities that they could not leave the country, according to reports reaching here from Moscow.

**TEL AVIV (WNS)** A petition urging that the town of Bethlehem, formerly held by Jordan, be incorporated into the municipal territory of Greater Jerusalem has been filed by a group of the town's Arab notables with the Israeli military governor of the area, it was disclosed here by government spokesmen who simultaneously noted that Bethlehem was not included in the territorial widening of Jerusalem. Signed by five hundred Arab notables, the petition said the request was based on social and economic considerations.

**NEW YORK:** - Morris B. Abram, President of the AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE, revealed today that his agency had urged the U.S. State Department to protest reported acts of violence against members of the Jewish community of Libya, estimated to number more than 3,000.

**VIENNA (WNS)** A nation-wide public opinion poll in Austria showed that 54% of the populace favored Israel in its war with the Arabs while only 11% favored an Arab victory.

**NEW YORK --** Twenty new Jewish military chaplains have entered the U.S. Armed Forces in time to plan Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year) services which they will conduct for Jewish military personnel, it was announced by Rabbi Selwyn D. Ruslander, chairman of the National Jewish Welfare Board Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy and spiritual leader of Temple Israel, Dayton, Ohio. Rosh Hashanah begins at sundown, October 4, and continues through sundown October 6.

**PARIS (WNS)** President Charles de Gaulle continues to be the target of criticism in the French press for the stand he took on the Mid-East crisis.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** Charles H. Jordan, executive vice-chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee and a leading expert on refugee problems, has suggested formation of an international task force "to survey past, present and future programs by all agencies on behalf of Arab refugees."

**GENEVA (WNS)** Added contributions to Israel in order to help repair the war damages and make up for the loss of income in ORT functions was approved here at a plenary session of the ORT executive.

**TEL AVIV (WNS)** Arabs in the Gaza Strip are to be permitted to travel to the occupied west bank of Jordan, it was declared here by Minister of Defense Moshe Dayan.

**BADEN BADEN (WNS)** The trial of a former Gestapo leader in the murder of 500 Norwegian Jews who were sent to the notorious Auschwitz death camp opened here amidst indications that the defendant, Helmut Reinhard, will claim he merely obeyed superior orders.

**AMSTERDAM (WNS)** Queen Juliana of Holland has named the famed Jewish scholar Dr. Gershom Scholem as a member of the Dutch Royal Academy.

**Jordan Less Hostile to Israel**

**LONDON (WNS)** A possible softening of Jordanian policy toward Israel was seen here in a report from Amman, capital of Jordan, that Premier Saad Jumaa had told Parliament that the Arabs must abandon their nineteen-year-long policy toward Israel.

While calling for an Arab summit meeting to reassess Arab thinking on Israel, the Premier blamed Jordan's catastrophe on the Arab leaders who, he said, had been disseminating misleading propaganda. He was particularly critical of Ahmed Shukeiry, head of the Palestine Liberation Organization, for boasting he would finish off the Jews and Israel in quick time. That line of propaganda, he asserted, was instead helpful to Israel since it served to rally world public opinion in support of the Jewish State.

At the same time the Premier revealed that Jordan suffered more than 6,000 casualties.

Meanwhile it was reported here by the Daily Telegraph that Israel was currently negotiating purchase

of 50 French Mirage M5 planes, with delivery to be made next year. However, shipment of the planes would largely depend on whether President de Gaulle of France rescinds his current embargo on the sale of arms to the Middle East.

Meanwhile military experts here who have been trying to evaluate the reason for Israel's quick victory over the combined power of three Arab states that had been amply supplied with Soviet weapons have come up with the conclusion that the Arab debacle was the result of grave mistakes in evaluating intelligence reports in the hours before the clash materialized. Had they not made those disastrous mistakes, the military experts are said to feel, they might have been able to put up stiffer resistance. One of the factors in the incredible Israeli victory was the fact that Israeli aircraft had been airborne some ninety minutes before the actual clashing by the land forces.
