All qualified veterans, widows, blind persons and orphans seeking their \$1000 exemption on real estate must be validated before the first Monday in August, or their claim cannot be honored.

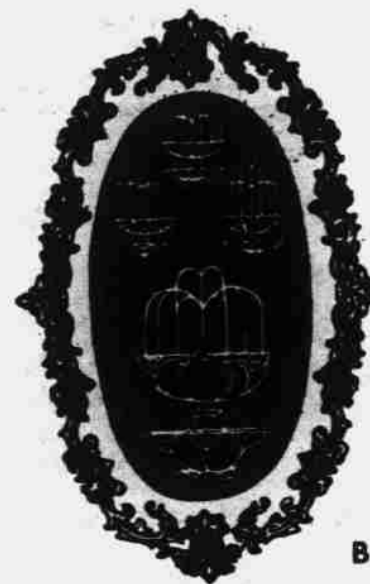
