

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) Arabs in the Israeli-held west bank sector are divided on the future of the region, some favoring the status quo and others an arrangement for the establishment of an autonomous Palestinian entity. This development emerged when a group of Arab notables in Bethlehem petitioned the Israeli military governor to incorporate the city and integrate it with Israel.

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WNS) Rumors of behind-the-scene efforts by the Big Three--the United States, the Soviet Union and Great Britain--to reach agreement on a formula for the solution of the Arab-Israel impasse circulated here among informed sources, with spokesmen for the three powers declining to comment on the reported development. It is believed the big powers would like to reach an accord on the issue before the final meeting of the fifth emergency session of the United Nations General Assembly.

HIGHLAND MILLS, N.Y. (WNS) Enlargement of its network of day schools throughout the United States and Canada as an instrument in preserving and promoting Jewish cultural value was voted here by the Farband-Labor Zionist Order at its five-day 21st national convention, attended by more than 750 delegates.

NEW YORK (WNS) The announced cancellation by the Government of Czechoslovakia of plans to observe the 1,000 anniversary of the Czech Jewish community has triggered sharp criticism by Rabbi Arthur J. Lelyveld, president of the American Jewish Congress.

LONDON (WNS) Jews in Salonika who suffered property and other material losses during the Nazi occupation of Greece are to be compensated by West Germany in the sum of \$1,250,000.

NEW YORK (WNS) Floyd B. McKissick, director of the Congress of Racial Equality and a leading Negro militant, has dissociated himself from a Black Power resolution condemning the "imperialist Zionist war" between Israel and the Arab countries.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Rep. Joel T. Broyhill, Virginia Republican, has asked the State Department whether the Arab embassies here had supplied anti-Israel propaganda to Black Power advocates and, if so, to determine whether there had been a sufficient breach of protocol to stamp the diplomats involved as personae non grata.

JERUSALEM (WNS) When Knesset reconvenes at the end of October one of its major problems will be weighing of a proffered proposal to offer special inducements designed to attract to Israel about 20,000 immigrants, preferably from the more affluent countries.

PARIS (WNS) Although more than three months have now passed since the outbreak of the Arab-Israel war, the anti-Jewish campaign of the extremist nationalist press in Morocco remains unabated, according to reports reaching here from reliable sources.

NEW YORK (WNS) Yeshiva University, in an effort to help alleviate the dearth of qualified Jewish high school teachers, has launched an educational program designed to prepare students for teaching at the secondary school level.

NEW YORK (WNS) Hebrew Day Schools in the New York Metropolitan area opened with a registration of 40,000 pupils, an increase of nearly 3% percent over last year.

LONDON (WNS) Thousands of Egyptian Jews and Jewish nationals who were not Egyptian citizens are still being held in concentration camps according to information reaching here from reliable sources.

TEL AVIV (WNS) Two Israeli tractors in separate parts of the country have been damaged by land mines.

BONN (WNS) Ilsa Koch, one of the most depraved criminals in the world of Nazi criminality, committed suicide in her prison cell at Aichach. (ED. NOTE: What took her so long?)

PARIS (WNS) Ilya Eherenburg, noted Soviet novelist, poet and journalist, died in Moscow at the age of 76 leaving unanswered the how and why of his survival under Stalin's purge of Jewish intellectuals.

BARNEMOUTH, England (WNS) A Jewish cemetery and synagogue here were found smeared with swastikas and anti-Semitic propaganda.

NEW YORK - The 70th Anniversary of the First Zionist Congress held in Basle, Switzerland, in 1897, will be observed by the American Zionist Council in a special commemorative program to be held on September 24th, at 515 Park Avenue, New York City.
