Sch-wartz, vice-president of the Israel Bond Organization, disclosed that the sale of Israel bonds from January 1 to Sept. 12 had totaled \$171,250,000. The sales, he said, reflected the burgeoning interest in Israel that had been triggered by the cosmetics that make up the Arab-Israel war. The previous high was in 1965, when the total sale for the year was \$91,000,000.


