

Reflection of U.N.

Watching the cynical performance of the Soviet delegate at the recent sessions of the Security Council the thought persisted: The Kremlin when it thought it would serve its purpose made a pact with Hitler while his hands were deep in Jewish blood and now it seemingly is in an immoral compact with the Arab hooligans who would, if they could, finish the job on Jews Hitler had left undone....

For let there be no mistake. Despite their pious protestations to the contrary, the Arab showed that they are not only the enemies of Israel but of all Jews. Their persistent charges in the UN that American Jews were dominating the White House and American policy in the Middle East was nothing but a transparent and vicious attempt to fan anti-Semitism in our country and to divide the faiths of an issue where faith has no relevance. What the Arabs have done was to make the UN a platform for the dis-

semination of lies about the Jewish role as part of a deliberate scheme to foment hatred against us in this country...

After listening to the dull, endless speeches in the Security Council, most of them as devoid of intellectual content and historic perspective as they were full of hypocrisy, we of the generation of the tragic League of Nations must wonder what the future holds for the new international forum. To say that the recent spectacle was neither elevating nor encouraging would be the understatement of the day....

One of the most painful developments has been the ugly role played by India at the Security Council sessions. Here the victims of communist aggression were playing the role of lackeys to Moscow when dignity and national pride demanded that they align themselves with the only democratic society in the Middle East -- Israel. From sources in Delhi this writer learns that there is a powerful undercurrent of opposition to official Indian policy both among intellectuals and lawmakers who are aware that, over the years, there has been a deep reservoir of goodwill for India in Israel and in the Jewish communities throughout the world....

The neutrality tune echoing through western capitals is much reminiscent of the pre-World War II days when the world's leaders were permitting Hitler to solve the Jewish problem through extermination for fear they would be violating the principle of national sovereignty if they asked Hitler to stop. That kind of neutrality is the mark of the moral eunuch. We have now witnessed an almost parallel spectacle in the United Nations, where for three weeks no so-called statesmen of the world have been engaging in a semantic game that is as boring as it is tragic for the world and for the future of the international body itself. Instead of acting as a moral force operating outside of the context of politically selfish motivation, the men in the high seats engaged in recrimination, vituperation and pettiness while the Middle East was in flames. The plain people in the world had reposed their hopes in statesmanship to avert catastrophe. The most recent UN performance gave no encouragement to that hope....

The Pope has issued an appeal for the safeguarding and the preservation of the holy Christian sites in Jerusalem. The Jewish world of course shares the Pontiff's concern, but it seems to this columnist that in an age of ecumenism this was not enough, particularly at a time when the new barbarians of the east were threatening to throw the survivors of the holocaust in Israel into the sea....

Total war, as the whole world knows, was a Hitlerite euphemism for the destruction of the Jews. A notebook I kept on recent developments shows that Nasser used it innumerable times and that his defenders in the Security

Council used it freely and often and menacingly....

One of the most radiant developments emerging from the current crisis has been the display of unity in the American Jewish community on aid to Israel. If that spirit of unity can be carried over to post-crisis days on an array of problems other than philanthropy, the Jewish community in America will be on its way to greater purpose.
