YOM KIPPUR....

Within hours we will be gathered in our synagogues and temples in prayer and in contemplation as the hand of judgment seals the script which is our fate for the coming year.

Over the year we sinned against man and transgressed against God and now, on this Sabbath of Sabbaths which is Yom Kippur, we ask forgiveness in the hope it will be given in the fullness of measure on the scale of judgment.

Judgment, in truth, is an eternal process. No day passes but there is judgment upon all of us. But this day has an aura transcending all the days of the year because it is the lone day in the year when each man is alone with his God, with his conscience, when each man unburdens himself of the darkneses, the secrets and the sins which weighted him down during the year. Now he has cast his sins into the waters and he is at one with man and the world, leaving the threshold of his sanctuary in the faith that while the decree is final, it may yet be diverted by repentance, charity and prayer.

There are a multitude of prayers said on Yom Kippur and many that are uttered in stillness from unwritten pages, but in essence they all add up to one supplication: May the Scribe in the coming year keep full covenant with our hopes.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE...

Now that the book is closed on the old year, it is well to pause in evaluation of one of the most dramatic events on the American Jewish scene--the remarkable response of the American Jewish community to the crisis that loomed over Israel as the year's benign season bloomed over our own land.

The clouds from the Arablands had been gathering over Israel for a long time, but now they were threatening to engulf the land and there was restlessness and anxiety in the Jewish enclaves of the world. Israel was history's answer to Hitler's abortive conspiracy and now its enemies were conspiring to undo the miracle and drive the rescued and the redeemed into the sea.

We had it from Sinai that the guardian of Israel neither sleeps nor slumbers and were therefore hopeful that when the confrontation came Israel would survive the crisis in triumph. But we remembered too that the hand that raised the tablet at Sinai was sustained by a power outside of itself and that if Israel's hand was to prevail over its enemies it must be sustained by Jewish hands everywhere.

Sociologists and students of the American Jewish scene are still puzzled by the phenomem that was Jewish giving in the days of crisis for Israel and its people. Some see in it a sign of Jewish maturity, of a pervading sense of responsibility. Others look at it as an indication that Jewish roots have struck deep in our soil. Still others view it as evidence of a hitherto undiscerned survival will in the American Jewish community.

On the other hand there are some -- among them J.I. Fishbein of the Sentinel in Chicago -- who fear the illusion of "equating the unprecedented outpouring of funds during the Arab-Israel crisis with a resurgence of Jewish vitality here at home." In Fishbein's opinion the response was primarily due to the fact that "we had visions of another holocaust in which two million Jews would be slaughtered." His fear is that once the emergency has subsided, American Jews will revert to the old pattern of ignoring the survival values that spell hemschech, ongoing.

A contrary view is taken in a recent issue of Commentary by Rabbi Herbert Hertzberg, who believes that the modd of the American Jewish community in the days of crisis for Israel had undergone "an abrupt radical and possible permanent change." But why? And will it last? Rabbi Hertzberg has no ready answer to those questions since -- he says -- that page in American Jewish history has not yet been properly studied and evaluated. However, he believes it "clear that the Middle East crisis represented a lightning flas which has illuminated the landscape of the American Jewish future."
