

VAN CLIBURN DEBUTS IN LAS VEGAS SAT

Van Cliburn, the pianist who has been world famous since his sensational triumph in Moscow in 1958, will make his first Las Vegas appearance at Las Vegas

Convention Center on Saturday, October 28 as part of his annual coast-to-coast tour under the aegis of S. Hurok.

Cliburn's current tour fol-

lows his latest series of spring and summer triumphs in Japan, Europe, and at the great American outdoor music festivals. His itinerary of nearly sixty cities will take him to Holland, Panama and Canada as well as throughout the United States.

The tall, youthful Texan has continued to display his remarkable hold on audiences throughout the world, attracting capacity audiences wherever he goes. He has made three return visits to the Soviet Union, the latest in 1965, since his historic victory in the Tchaikovsky Competition.

Cliburn is beginning to make appearances as a conductor to go along with his pianistic activities. His series of recordings for RCA Victor have consistently been among the industry's best sellers. After he drew a record crowd of 35,000 to the Robin Hood Dell in July, 1965 the Philadelphia Inquirer said of him succinctly "Van Cliburn is a musical institution."

Tickets for the Cliburn concert, which will begin promptly at 8:30, are now on sale at the Convention Center boxoffice.
