Among the distinguished non-speech-making dignitaries who interrupted busy schedules to pay their respects, were U.S. Senators Alan Bible and Howard Cannon and Lieut. Gov. Ed Fike. Supreme Court Justice John Mowbray, sporting a leg in a cast, the price of

indulging in a ball game with his sons, held court from a wall-side chair during the cocktail hour. State Senator Mahlon Brown, our own Assemblyman Eileen Brokman and Assemblyman Frank Young were there, as were Dist. Court Judge Bill Compton and our popular Mayor Oran Gragson with his darling Bonnie.

It was significant to this writer, that despite the lack of participation of some hotels with their customary oversize pledges, the number of smaller purchases more than made up for the deficit. This is a healthy sign, with more and more individuals supporting the cause of Israel. The overall amount raised was in respectable range of our annual quota.

A 'Light' For Soviet Jewry
