The Jews have a record of longevity other peoples will find it hard put to match.

Chosen or not, they have maintained a contiguity and continuity since Abraham made the covenant with God. While this record should ride high in history, there comes with it a large measure of responsibility, not only to themselves but to the world community at whatever period they either assumed pre-eminence or became a matter of concern.

One of the ways the Jews maintained their folk identity was by communication.

The essential element of this communication was the Bible and, thereafter, the Talmud, the Mishnah, the commentaries and the indigenous tomes over the generations. Almost everywhere a Jew found himself, he found another with whom he could communicate, either in language or tradition.

In the modern day and age, with the rapidity of physical transport, this has become more difficult and simpler. Difficult because of the mass of differences between nations and simpler because of the ease of contact. But communication is essential and one of the prouder, if smaller, records the Jewish people have established has been the existence for the past fifty years of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

Founded in Holland in 1917, with the view to maintaining a link between the Jewish communities on either side of the battle lines, the JTA today has offices and correspondents all over the Western world.

The JTA is the only major source of worldwide Jewish news and a key link in communications among Jews all over. It has withstood the test and ordeal of time, has weathered financial crises, but always it remained steadfast in its mission of bringing the news.

November marks the fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the JTA, an event that merits observance in all Jewish communities of the world, including our own.


