JORDAN'S KING HUSSEIN FIRST ARAB LEADER TO

ACKNOWLEDGE ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) King Hussein of Jordan, appearing on a television interview program and at the United Nations Security Council meeting, stated publicly for the first time that he was prepared to recognize Israel's right to exist in peace and security. At the same time he said that the recognition would depend upon the boundaries Israel negotiated with the Arab states. He also declared that President Nasser of the United Arab Republic was ready to allow ships flying the Israeli flag to use the Suez Canal if a general settlement were reached.

(At the same time, a band of Arab saboteurs made a

dramatic escape at dawn across the Jordan River under covering fire provided by Jordanian soldiers on the east bank, according to a communique from Jerusalem. The Jordanian fire pinned down the Israeli troops pursuing the eight saboteurs, who had dynamited several buildings in a nearby Israeli settlement.

(This was the first time Jordanian forces had overtly assisted the saboteurs, who have been striking repeatedly in the Beisan valley, south of the Sea of Galilee. The assistance as an apparent contradiction of King Hussein's declared opposition to the terrorist campaign.)

DESECRATION SHOCKING

JERUSALEM (WNS) — A shocking record of destruction and desecration of Jewish holy places in and around Old Jerusalem during 19 years of Jordanian rule has been documented in the recently released report of an inter-ministerial committee that was appointed after the Six-Day War to determine the state of Jewish shrines in Jordan-held territory.

Zerach Warhaftig, Minister of Foreign Affairs, summarized the committee's findings at a press conference here. He said that 56 or 58 synagogues in Jordan-held Jerusalem had been destroyed completely and that the Jewish cemetery on the Mount of Olives, in continuous use for more than 2,000 years, was almost totally destroyed.

The cemetery was one of the Jewish holy places to which access was promised by Jordan in the 1949 armistice agreement, but the promise was never kept, Dr. Warhaftig said. Tombstones

were carried away for purposes ranging from fortifying mortar positions to building lavatories, according to the report. "Documentary evidence and eye witnesses make it clear beyond a doubt that the desecration of the cemetery was carried out by Jordanian authorities for official purposes," Dr. Warhaftig declared.

He added that there was only one known instance of a clergyman protesting against the desecration and he was told by the Jordanian authorities to mind his own business. Moslem officials whom Dr. Warhaftig questioned on the outrages disclaimed all knowledge.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Arab sabotage and terrorist groups were consolidated recently under the command of Ahmed Shukeiry's Palestine Liberation Front, Beirut newspapers have reported. The new consolidating organization, known as "Jataf," will supercede El Fatah.

U. S. JEWS GROWING PAINS

NEW YORK. American Jews are encountering growing problems, both internal and external, in preserving their Jewishness, according to a pioneering five-year study of American Jewish life.

1. Internally, they find difficulty in accepting the traditional Jewish religion with its numerous daily rituals. But they feel that today's Judaism, which stresses the

ethical concepts of Judaism almost to the exclusion of the ritual, does not differentiate them sufficiently from the rest of the community.

2. Externally, they are made uneasy by the attitudes of their Gentile neighbors, who see Jewishness as an obstacle to Jewish integration into the general society. Accordingly, the study re-

veals, Jews are frequently "tentative and uncertain" about their pattern of life, and they appear to be exploring what the precise role of ritual in the family's religious scheme should be.
