As you may be aware that we are now constructing a 150 unit complex on Washington Street near Bonanza Road. This complex was due to be completed on January 10, 1968; however, due to several factors on labor and material, the construction will possibly be delayed six weeks to two months.

We are now taking applications at the office of the Archie C. Grant Park, 1720 Searles, where all those interested will have an opportunity to file their application, giving pertinent information to establish the applicants eligibility.
