ISRAELITE ADS PAY

NEW YORK (WNS) Maj. Gen. Itzhak Rabin, until recently Israeli Chief of Staff who is expected to become the next Israeli Ambassador to Washington, told the UJA conference that he cound not "state with certainty" that the recent 6-day Israeli-Arab conflict was the final me. "The Arab states still nave not reconciled themselves to Israel's existence," he declared. Concluding his address, Gen. Rabin said: "It is our right to say

to the Arabs; if you desire a peace agreement, let us reach a mutual understanding -- a peace treaty -and we should be prepared to withdraw to lines much more constricted than the areas we are now holding. areas we are now holding. But if you desire war, continued hatred and non-recognition of Israel's existence, then we do not give up a single yard."

Aryeh L. Pincus, chair-

man of the Jewish Agency, told the delegates that "milltions upon millions of dollars are needed from the UJA just to hold the line in the field of social welfare." The Six-Day War, he said, cost Israel's people many hundreds of million dollars, "and now, in order to stay militarily abreast of the rearmed and still belligerent Arab states, Israel's people must continue to spend more hundreds of millions. The vast costs of minimal social services for nearly a halfmillion struggling immigrants must still be faced," Mr. Pincus stated.

Other major addresses were delivered by Baron Elie de Rothschild, of Paris; Sir Barnett Janner of London: Dr. Moses Roses, of Bucharest, chief rabbi of Rumania; Rabbi Herbert A. Friedman, executive vice-chairman of the UJA, and Louis Broido, chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee.

ISRAEL WILL RETALIATE

TEL AVIS (WNS) Yigal Allon, Israel Minister of Labor, insisted Israel would reply in kind to any attack by Egyptians using missiles and other advanced weapons upon her population centers.

In a speech in Haifa, Mr. Allon had said that "every weapon Egypt can produce or purchase with the aid of a great power we can match, sometimes with and sometimes without the aid of a big power." He warned Egypt that the shelling of the oil refineries in Suez last October in retaliation for the sinking of the destroyer Eilat should teach her what to expect if she bombed Israeli cities from the air, the ground or the sea, Mr. Allon pointed out that with the front now on the Suez Canal, Egypt's population centers were much more vulnerable than those of Israel.

Israel Government officials declined to say whether Israel had information that President Nasser of the United Arab Republic was planning an attack on Israeli cities. It is public knowledge that Egyptian forces have been training to fire missiles acquired from the Soviet Union, These include Luna ground-to-ground rockets

and Styx missiles launched from ships.

FRANCE LIFTS ARMS EMBARGO ON ARABS

WASHINGTON (WNS) --France has lifted its arms embargo on the Arab nations and may ship to the Arabs some of the arms manufactured for Israel, It was announced in Paris that France was negotiating a large sale of military equipment to Iraq. The embargo imposed on the Arab states and Israel after the outbreak of the Six-Day War has been lifted for the Arabs.

(The Paris daily L'Aurore reported that France would sell 50 Mirage-V jet fighters to Iraq, 15- Mirage-E 3 jets and eight Nord Atlas jet bombers. The newspaper Combat denounced reports of French sale of aircraft to Iraq, asserting that doing, increase the danger of Israel."

(Official French sources declined to comment on the reported sales to Iraq and on reports that the planes sold to that Arab state were the aircraft Israel had ordered but had not received because of the de Gaulle embargo.)

de Gaulle has the Gall

Madame Du Barry, the most notorious tramp in French history, was a lady compared to de Gaulle.

The French President, at one time considered an honest leader of a Democratic republic, held a press conference this month wherein he removed all ambiguity about his objectives.

He revealed himself as a double-crosser of decent French people and friends of France, in the same manner and means slyly utilized by Castro to hoodwink decent Cubans and others who supported the revolt against Batista. Both these ungrateful bums duped the very ones who had contributed the most to put them in power. Brave revolutionists and sympathetic Americans, like Hemingway, risked their lives and fortunes in the hopes that Cuba would become a free nation. Rightists supported de Gaulle in 1947, when he denounced Soviet Russia as an enemy as dangerous as Nazi Germany. When he was elected president in 1958, France was weak and divided, but at least she had friends, well-wishers and allies. Today, France's friends are strictly among the satelites, whose friendship would be broken as quickly as a word.

We've suspected for some time where de Gaulle stood but events in recent months brought a full disclosure o. his deception. The French President is nothing but a Commy slob taking orders from the Kremlin.

Here in chronological order are the movements of

de Gaulle since July, 1966:

Simultaneously with France's withdrawal from NATO, and American bases removed from France, he visited Russia and was hailed by the Reds. The next month de Gaulle deliberately neglected to present U. S. Secretary of State Dean Rusk's peace proposals to North Vietnam. (Continued on Page 4)
