Three and a half years ago, the elegant Four Fountains restaurant, between the Sands and the Flamingo, opened under the direction of Joe Kludjian and Jim Hoffman.

Since that time the restaurant has gained fame and popularity with tourists and local diners alike for it is the one place in Las Vegas where the diner can select his lobster, alive, from today's showworld.

In the restaurant's foyer is a large aquarium which holds a generous supply of the seafood delicacy. Regularly a new supply is flown in from Maine seaports to provide patrons the freshest, finest lobster.

The Four Fountains comprises two plush rooms, the Venetian and the Florentine, and an intimate cocktail lounge, where Danny, dispenses the diner's favorite libation.

Both rooms are decorated to reflect the genuine Italian atmosphere of the Renaissance period. Throughout are cushy gold upholstered booths accenting the rich flocked red wallpaper broken by white columns.

Throughout the rooms are statuary replicas of the Italian masters, Michelangelo, Leonardo de Vinci, Raphael and Donatello. The wide expanses of the walls are broken by photographs of famous Italian street scenes.

Heavy ornate cut glass on a gold fillagree chandeliers provide a posh subdued glow.

Besides broiled Maine Lobster the Four Fountains is noted for its other entrees from the broiler. Such Italian cuisine as chicken Cacciatore, veal cutlet, Parmegiana and veal Scallopine — prepared to special recipes of Chef Hoffman — delight the diner.

If seafood and Italian food doesn't suit the diner's fancy, the Four Fountains also offers Eastern corn-fed beef, Prime Rib — Diamond Jim cut, brochette of beef, shish kebabs and Chateau Briand bouquetiere.

Open seven days a week, the Four Fountain's hours are 5 p.m. until midnight. Local people or tourists who enjoy the Four Fountains will find equally fine food at the La Strada in Laguna Beach, which Joe and Jim operate.


