ion would be the first phase of an overall Arab-Israeli agreement on the Middle East crisis.

The plan was proposed to the General Assembly's special political committee by Ambassador Michael S. Comay, Israel's representative to that 123-member committee, which has been debating the problem of the Arab refugees for the last week.

Shortly after Mr. Comay introduced his plan, the United States introduced a draft resolution deploring the fact that "no substantial progress has been made on the reintegration or resettlement" of the Arab refugees. The U. S. urged, among other steps, that the UN's special Arab refugee relief - set - up, the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine refugees (UNRWA), "continue" its efforts to rectify the relief rolls "to assure the most equitable distribution of relief based on

need." One of the points made in Israel's presentation disagreed sharply with the UNRWA statistics from which the relief rolls are made up by the agency, calling many of the figures "inflated."

In a lengthy speech before the committee, Ambassador Comay declared that his government had been working on detailed and practical proposals to solve the refugee problem, but it did not have the capacity to operate alone - but only through an international and regional plan within "the broad framework of an effort to establish a permanent peace."

He appealed to the Arab states, particularly, to consider the Israeli proposal seriously "on simple humanitarian grounds." He urged the Arab nations to "move along the path of reconciliation."

Mr. Comay reminded the delegates that the recent annual report of UNRWA acti-

vities, filed here by Laurence Michelmore, the agency Commissioner - General, had remarked on the "effective" cooperation of Israel with the agency. Mr. Comay complimented the agency on its "zeal and devotion" and its general labors. He pointed out that the Israel Government had contributed services and money to the value of two million Israeli pounds to UNRWA since the June War and that it was considering a further contribution to be earmarked for vocational training for Arab refugee youth.

However, the ambassador questioned many of the figures on refugee population and movements as reported by Mr. Michelmore, saying that much of the date -- which was furnished by the Arab "host" governments - was "inflated" and grossly inaccurate. He questioned particularly Mr. Michelmore's references to the matter of textbooks for Arab schools in the Israeli - occupied territories.

complaint about a shortage of textbooks, Mr. Comay said it had been necessary to remove objectionable anti-Israel and anti-Semitic material -- in accordance with the position of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) that education promote understanding and tolerance among all racial and religious groups. He added that Israel was now prepared to fulfill all orders from UNRWA for a complete range of textbooks in the Arab schools in the Israeli - occupied area.
