PROFILES

BILL

Las Vegas is where you belong, BILL MILLER, we suggested, and he wholeheartedly agreed with me. So today's 'Profile' goes to Mr. Showmanship himself, BILL MILLER, and in show business he's known from coast to coast.

His appointment as entertainment director of both the Flamingo and International hotels represents something of the return of the prodigal son to the scene of many former triumphs in this particular field of endeavor.

In the 40's and 50's the lights of Bill Miller's Riviera, a nightclub located just over the George Washington Bridge in Ft. Lee, New Jersey, was the brightest view you could see from the Manhattan side of the Hudson River. Figuratively, they were also the brightest lights in the night club world at that time.

At the Riviera, Miller in-

itiated the night club careers of Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Jerry Lewis, Danny Thomas, Joey Bishop, Tony Martin, Lena Horne, and a host of others. Although 20 years have passed he remains a close personal friend of these stars today. In fact the difference between the sums Bill Miller paid these people then and what their weekly stints earn today is a subject of great jest between them.

In 1953, Bill moved into the Las Vegas scene as a part owner and director of entertainment at the Sahara Hotel. That started a long and eventful association with the Nevada show world, a venture that saw Bill launch great nightclub careers for such headliners as Marlene Dietrich, Red Skelton, Donald O'Connor, Ray Bolger, Wayne Newton, Ames Brothers, Kathryn Grayson, and many more.

He accomplished many first feats. He became the originator of the first big-
