

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS) An announcement disclosing that baking of matzoth for the forthcoming Passover season have begun in Moscow on January 7 and that the early start was designed to head off the anticipated matzoh demand was made here by the Soviet Embassy when it distributed copies of a press release by the Novosti News Agency reporting the development.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Last week's 12-inch snow is largely melted now but the money of the event will long linger on in the memory of the residents of this city who could not believe that a city in so benign a climate could be so stricken by snow, wind and storm.

LONDON (WNS) The High Court of the Soviet Latvian Republic is Riga is currently trying five Nazi collaborators accused of engineering and participating in the wiping out of the entire Jewish community in the Latvian town of Daupepils during World War II. The defendants served as Nazi executioners during the German occupation of the Baltic state.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Official announcement that Maj. General Itzhak Rabin had been named Israeli Ambassador to the United States said the commander of Israel's forces in last June's war with the Arabs would assume his post next month as successor to Avraham Harman.

NEW YORK (WNS) Although the dire prophecies concerning the "vanishing" American Jew have proven premature, there is the distinct danger that if there is no harnessing of the climate for on-going commitment to Jewish life generated by the Six-Day Arab Israeli War last summer, "the sentiments of last summer may evaporate and an unusual opportunity will have been lost," was sounded by Jacob Katzman, national secretary of the Farband - Labor Zionist Order.

BONN (WNS) Life terms for seven of fifteen men on trial on charges of having murdered 120,000 Jews in East Galicia, were asked by the State Prosecutor as their trial was nearing completion.

WASHINGTON (WNS) The activities of extremist factions in the Negro community have "created confusion in the minds of Jews who had supported the goals of the Negro revolution," according to Rabbi Jay Kaufman, executive vice president of B'Nai B'rith.

NEW YORK (WNS) A petition urging easing of Jewish marriage, divorce and inheritance laws affecting women has been drafted by the International Council of Jewish Women.

PARIS (WNS) More than eighty-five percent of the losses suffered by the Arab countries in last year's war with Israel have been made good by the Soviet Union, which is preparing to ship even greater amounts of military supplies to that area of the world, according to an estimate in Figaro by its military expert Roger Massip, who wrote Moscow was reading to turn over to Egypt a brand new warplane, the Mig-23, which currently is being used by the Soviet air force.

GENEVA (WNS) The Joint Distribution Committee has allocated \$62,500 for the relief of the victims of the earthquake in Sicily.

BONN (WNS) If Czechoslovakia does not change its hostile attitude toward Israel he will not return to his native land, the Czech writer Vladislav Macacko declared in a TV interview here.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Meir Wilner, leader of the Communist Party in Israel, joined in a statement by the East German Communist Party branding Israel the aggressor in the June war with the Arabs.

LONDON The Daily Telegraph, in a report last Saturday said President de Gaulle will lift the French arms embargo against Israel within thirty days and permit delivery of the 50 Mirage V jets Israel purchased from France before the June war. According to the Newspaper, the de Gaulle decision has been influenced by former Premier David Ben Gurion, with whom he had exchanged letters late last year.

BIG GUNS BOOM

JERUSALEM (WNS) Israeli and Jordanian troops exchanged mortar fire across the Jordan River for four hours last Sunday. An Israeli army spokesman said the Jordanians opened up with artillery early in the morning against Israeli forces, 14 miles north of the Damiya Bridge which links Jordan with the Israeli-occupied west bank. A Jordanian spokesman monitored here claimed that the Israelis used artillery as well.

ARAB MURDER

TEL AVIV (WNS) - An Israeli soldier was killed when the jeep he was driving was struck by a bazooka shell fired from ambush along a road south of Tirat Zvi in the Beisan Valley, about a mile and a half from the banks of the Jordan River. A second soldier in the jeep was not injured. The attackers evaded a search begun immediately after the incident, and apparently succeeded in escaping.

WHOLE ERETZ ISRAEL

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- An audience of 3,000 that included many prominent Israelis, among them Nobel Laureate S.Y. Agnon, attended a rally of the new "Movement for a Whole Eretz Israel," and heard an equally distinguished group of speakers urge permanent retention by Israel of all territories captured during the Six Day War. However, opposition to the "Movement" has also developed.

RED PROPAGANDA

WASHINGTON (WNS) A sharp statement in support of Syria and exhorting the Arabs to liquidate Israel has been issued in Peking by the Afro-Asian Writers Bureau. A Peking propaganda front, the Bureau termed Israel "a tool of aggression in the hands of the imperialists headed by the United States."
