UNforgivable UN

If some no good, irresponsible degenerate, climbed through the window of this writer's home in the dead of night, and killed members of our family, and threatened to murder more, we'd chase that despicable bum into his house to take away the gun and to Hell with any laws we'd be breaking about invasion of his property.

We'd be upholding the first law of nature -- self preservation.

That's exactly the situation in Israel.

For the United Nations to condemn Israel under similar circumstances is deplorable. For the United States to be in accord with the unanimous vote of condemnation is ridiculous and contrary to the feelings and opinions of every loyal American who has given the matter any thought. For Arthur Goldberg, U. S. Ambassador to the U. N., and a Jew, to lend his name to this deceit, is unforgivable. We'd resign first.

Calling the decision a compromise victory for the Western nations is the biggest lie of all.

The United Nations, the administration running the United States and Arthur Goldberg are collaborators in another triumph for Russia. This is just one more step in a vast series of events to discredit the United States and the Democratic nations in the eyes of the world. The International gold problem, the Pueblo incident, the invasion of Laos and the anti-Semitic outburst in Poland, are just a few of the instigations in the plot to convert us all to Communism. What makes it all the more calamitous is the part the administration is playing in aiding and abetting these nefarious Red schemes.

The Las Vegas Israelite, here and now, condemns the United Nations as an arm of Russia and a tool for the promulgation of Communist propaganda. The intentions of the world body may have been genuine at its formation - to preserve world peace - but it is anything but that now. It did nothing to preserve world peace in South Korea and it is doing nothing for the same cause in Vietnam. Just as the Reds have taken over the heads of countries like Democratic France and Cuba, and have taken over groups in America and elsewhere, they have gained control of the U.N., and therefore, for all intensive purposes, we

UN RIPS INTO ISRAEL PATTYCAKES THE ARABS

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WNS) After five days of deliberations which threatened at times to end in futility, the Security Council, heavily loaded with pro-Arab representation, adopted a resolution condemning Israel for last week's military thrust against Arab terrorist bases in Jordan while delivering a gentle reprimand to violators of the cease-fire.

Inclusion in the resolution of a clause that the Council "implores all violent incidents in violation of the ceasefire" was agreed upon by the Council members on the insistence of Ambassador Arthur J. Goldberg of the United States, who indicated the U.S. would not go along with the resolution of condemnation as originally drawn. Immediately after adoption of this formulation, there was speculation in the halls of the United Nations whether this would be interpreted by the Arab states as meaning that it was applicable to them directly and not to saboteurs and terrorists who were conducting guerilla operations in Israel. This was hinted at prior to the adoption of the resolution by King Hussein of Jordan when he declared in Amman that the saboteurs were patriots who were fighting for the liberation of the occupied area and that they merited the support of the Jordanian people and the government. However, Ambassador Goldberg told the Council that the U. S., in supporting the resolution, had taken into account all types of violence in violation of the cease-fire.

The ink on the resolution had hardly dried, when reports reaching here from Israel disclosed that saboteurs killed two Israelis at a border settlement. The marauders, using Russian rifles, were engaged in battle by an Israeli patrol that sighted them. Jordanians also renewed shelling of kibbutz Maim Chaim after shelling Kfar

Ruppin. The shelling stopped when the guerilla guns were silenced by airforce fire.

Also in Israel, it was disclosed that a high-ranking Jordanian officer who was captured in last week's operation said he had received explicit orders from his superiors to turn blind eyes to terrorists and not to prevent their crossing into Israel territory, thus indicating that Jordan was guilty of complicity in the actions of the terrorists. And in Amman, a radio broadcast boasted on the basis of claims by terrorists, that, if left alone, the saboteurs could liquidate Israel within three years.

HEY UN READ THIS

JERUSALEM (WNS) Israel has instructed its diplomats abroad to communicate to the governments of the countries in which they are stationed its serious concern over the mounting incidents of sabotage from Jordan. Within a period of 48 hours last week there were a series of mining and bombing incidents in the Jordan Valley, Jerusalem and the Negev, including an exchange with a band of infiltrators north of the Damiya bridge. In one of the incidents a taxi driver and two of his passengers were wounded seriously. In another incident, an Israel soldier was injured when his vehicle struck a mine. And near the Mandelbaum Gate in Jerusalem a bomb ripped a gasoline station, setting off a spectacular fire.

STOP WASTING TIME

JERUSALEM (WNS) U. N. Special envoy Dr. Gunnar Jarring and Foreign Minister Abba Eban met here again in their continuing talks on finding a formula which would lead to Arab-Israel peace talks, but in view of Egypt rejection of Dr. Jarring's efforts it is doubtful any further progress will be reported.
