Today's 'Profile' goes to my good friend Assemblyman **NORMAN TY HILBRECHT**. As an Assemblyman he represents Blue Diamond, Indian Springs, Paradise Valley and all of Las Vegas. He is a lawyer in partnership with Terry Jones, with offices at 401 South 3rd Street (The Executive Towers). Both he and Jones attended school together and have been good friends since.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A resolution calling on the Government of the United States to withhold resumption of diplomatic ties with, and economic aid to, Egypt until President Nasser has entered into peace with Israel was introduced in the House by Rep. AMSTERDAM (WNS) Survivors of the notorious Auschwitz death camp, where hundreds of thousands of Jews perished in the ovens, have filed a protest against the Polish Government's current anti-Semitic campaign.

LONDON (WNS) President Nasser of Egypt on his way next month to the Arab summit meeting in Morocco will visit President de Gaulle of France.
