

Passover Message

The recollection of the words of Exodus 12:13, "I will pass over you, and no plague shall fall upon you to destroy you," are particularly meaningful this Passover when the people of Israel find it necessary to fight for their survival against a new wave of terrorism and Arab belligerency.

It is tragic that the festival of Passover, which commemorates the liberation of the Israelites from Egyptian bondage thousands of years ago, should be celebrated this year when modern Israel must unhappily fight for the protection of its citizens. Would that this Passover be celebrated in the joyous recollection of liberation!

But this is a time of crisis for Israel. Men of good will everywhere hoped that the Six Day War would have achieved the ultimate recognition by the Arab states of Israel's statehood that is necessary for a lasting peace in the Middle East. Unfortunately, however, the continuing acts of terrorism indicate that Israel must remain on its guard and that world Jewry must remain steadfast in its support of the Jewish state which next month celebrates its twentieth anniversary.

As we seat ourselves at the Seder table, in this year 5728, Jewry everywhere must rededicate itself to the message of Passover, the holiday which more than any other symbolizes man's eternal struggle for individual freedom and national liberation.

PHILADELPHIA (WNS) A prominent Jewish leader has urged the Jewish community of America to participate in what he called "mature inter-religious" dialogues and to adopt a "responsive approach" to the "continuing interest" of Pope Paul VI and Catholic liberals in strengthening Catholic-Jewish relations. Addressing a meeting of B'nai B'rith's National Commission on Adult Jewish Education, Dr. William A. Wexler, B'nai B'rith president, said he favored that course because of the fact that the Jewish community was "neither isolated from nor immune to the religious pluralism of its surroundings and the ecumenical atmosphere should be able to sustain even theological dialogues without distorting them into theological debates."

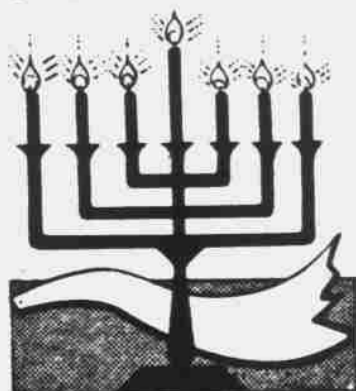

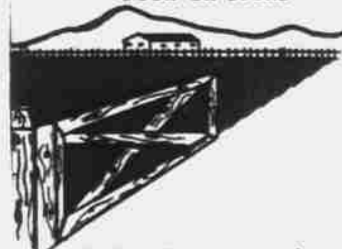
