PALACE THURS., MAY 9, LONDON (WNS) A petition urging the Soviet Union to extend to its Jewish nationals the rights accorded to all other minority groups was signed here by 225 professors and teachers at twenty British universities.

BONN(WNS) Belief that efforts are afoot to renew diplomatic ties with the Arab countries was voiced here by informed circles following talks between the West German Minister for Economic Assistance, Hans Jurgen Wischenewski, and Hadi El Kabany, a representative of the Arab League. The Arab countries broke diplomatic relations with West Germany two and a half years ago when Bonn established diplomatic relations with Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS) Foreign Minister Abba Eban of Israel, in an introduction to a book entitled "Israel" by Robert St. Johns, said that one of the significant factors in the current tension in the Middle East is the fact that the Arab mind "has never grasped" the "depth" of the "authenticity of Israel's roots in Middle East life."
