

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

**MUENSTER (WNS)** Three former Nazi police officers were sentenced here to life terms for participating in the slaughter of 230,000 Jews and others during World War II.

**NEW YORK.** National leaders in many fields will pay tribute to Morris B. Abram, President of the American Jewish Committee who will become President of Brandeis University in September, at the Committee's 62d Annual Dinner, to be held May 23, at the Americana Hotel in New York.

**NEW YORK (LNS)** - About three hundred members of the Lubavitch Youth Organization who gathered at the Lubavitch Center to mark the organization's thirteenth year, were informed 'Tefillin Campaign' - initiated by the Lubavitcher Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, on the eve of the Six Day War - nearly one million Jews have been given the opportunity to observe the Mitzvah of Tefillin, many doing so for the first time.

**NEW YORK --** The American Jewish Congress warned that Sunday's election success of the Neo-Nazi NPD Party in Baden Wurttemberg "cannot be dismissed as routine or as reflecting merely the normal percentage of extremist sentiment that may be found in any electorate."

**LONDON (WNS)** Israel should hold on to the occupied Arab territories until an effective peace settlement has been reached, former British Foreign Secretary Selwyn Lloyd told a huge audience at an Israel Independence Day rally at Albert Hall.

**PARIS (WNS)** Former Premier David Ben Gurion was quoted here by the weekly L'Express as having told its correspondent in an interview in Israel that Israel must have five million Jews before the end of the century "not for security reasons but in order to build the civilization we want."

**PARIS (WNS)** Egyptian students here assaulted and seriously injured an Iraqi intellectual, Abdedl Hamid, for urging Arab acceptance of Israel in a letter to the French newspaper La Monde.

**GENEVA (WNS)** Christians and Jews from all parts of the world, including Israel, are slated to convene here early in June in a "consultation" under the aegis of the World Council of Churches. The parley's agenda is expected to cover inter-faith relations the Middle East and other political problems.

**STUTT GART (WNS)** One of the longest trials of Nazi criminals in Germany ended here with the conviction of eleven of fifteen defendants on charges of involvement in the slaying of more than 400,000 Jews in Lvov, Poland, but only one of them was given a life sentence - former SS Sergeant Ernst Epple.

Two hundred and fourteen witnesses, many of them coming to Germany from abroad, testified at the trial, which began in October of 1966.

**TEL AVIV (WNS)** The possibility of "a state of non-belligerency" rather than a formal state of peace between Israel and the Arab countries was projected here by Minister of Defense Moshe Dayan in an interview with a reporter for the evening newspaper Maariv.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** More active Soviet intervention in the event of a new Arab-Israel conflict was predicted here by Dr. Hanum Goldmann at a press conference at which he said his prognostication was based on information he had received from Eastern European leaders. Dr. Goldmann is president of the World Zionist Organization and of the World Jewish Congress.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** United HIAS Service has offered to assume, if necessary, responsibility for travel arrangements, processing expenses and auxiliary costs for Jewish families in Poland wishing to rejoin their families in the United States, Canada, Brazil, Australian or other Western countries.

**SAN FRANCISCO (WNS)** Declaring that Israel's 20th anniversary celebration is a time not only of celebration but also of rededication, Dr. Emanuel Neumann said, "We must prepare our people and steel ourselves to face whatever trials or struggles that may still lie ahead." The veteran Zionist leader was president of the Zionist Organization of American when the State of Israel was proclaimed.

be troublemakers. In addition, the city was guarded against attack by helicopters that circled the area like birds on an urgent mission. But there were no incidents, except for a few people who fell prostrate because of the heat. There were no reports of any acts of sabotage or terror.

The reviewing stand was built on a hilltop in Jerusalem on the road on which the Arab Legion marched in 1948 on its path to capture the old city of Jerusalem. It was the same road on which an armored Israeli brigade marched last June to retake the old city.

One of the most attractive features of the event was the marching of a women's unit of soldiers who for the first time were permitted to carry machine guns in their hands as they marched. The Arabs in old Jerusalem largely kept away from the parade, nevertheless many of them could not resist looking on from behind shuttered windows and roof tops.
