ber of the B'nai B'rith, and his name is on the list of most any fund drive and a multitude of other events. He was (1950) President of the B'nai B'rith, for which he served as an active member of the board of directors for 22 years.

Harry helped organize Transwestern Life Insurance Company (in. 1958) as treasurer and member of the board of directors. He also served as treasurer and member of the board of directors of the Nevada Savings and Loan and currently is serving as member of the board of directors for the Nevada National Bank of Commerce.

The signal honor being accorded Harry is due to his dedicated service for many years as a member of the housing authority and also in recognition of his activity in local civic, religious and community affairs.

Having a deep and sympathetic feeling for the well being of the needy and elderly, he has devoted untold hours to the cause of decent and suitable housing for all citizens for which he has received no remuneration. He now serves as Chairman of the Housing Authority.
