Heading the cast of "Princess" is vivacious and talented Janice Hague - currently making her Las Vegas debut in the Desert Inn spectacular Pzazz '68 in the featured roles as the singing and flying Miss Millie Poppins and the sultry Dorothy Lamour in the show's salute to the "Road" pictures. The 23 year old actress-singer-dancer was born and raised in Los Angeles. Janice has a B. A. in Theater Arts from Immaculate Heart College and has been featured with the Sacramento Civic Light Opera. She also appeared at Melodyland, Circle Star Theater and Carosel Theater in such productions as "Guys and Dolls" with Ed Ames, "Half a Sixpence" with Noel Harrison, "Carousel" with John Raitt and "Sound of Music." TONI SERRATELLO - as Mary - was recently seen as the ingenue lead in "The Impossible Years" and has been active in the Las Vegas Theater Arts Players, NSU Children's Theater and Community Theater. A dancer and model as well as an actress, Toni was Miss Israel for the International Hotel ground breaking ceremonies.

SAM SAXON - as the King - is a Las Vegas junior high school teacher, Boy Scout leader, and currently in the McDonald's Playhouse production of "The Legend of Buffalo Bill" as Chief Cut Nose.
