JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) A bomb explosion in the city of Gaza took the lives of four people, all members of one family. It is believed the house stored explosives for terrorist organizations or that the bomb was set off by terrorists in reprisal for the family's alleged collaboration with the Israel police.

WASHINGTON (WNS) The size of the Soviet Jewish delegation to the United States at the invitation of the American Council for Judaism has been reduced from four to two, according to a disclosure by the Soviet Embassy here, Joining Moscow's Chief Rabbi Yehudah Leib Levin will be Cantor David Stiskin of Leningrad, The two other rabbis who were to have been in the delegation were Rabbi Israel Schvartsblat of Odessa and Rabbi Israel Bronfman of Derbent, Daghestan. No explanation was offered for the cancellation. The Chief Rabbi is expected to arrive in the U. S. on or about June 10.

LONDON (WNS) A summer camp in Poland which in the past offered Jewish children an opportunity to receive a Jewish education during the summer months has been closed by the Polish Government. The camps were closed by order of the Polish Ministry of Education, Among the courses taught at the camps was Yiddish and Jewish literature.

PARIS (WNS) Although several weeks have now passed since the removal of Hersch Smoliar as editor of the Warsaw Communist Yiddish daily, the Folkshtimme, no effort has been made to replace him.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Fifty-five leading American intellectuals, scholars and writers, among then Nobel Prize winner Prof. George Wald and former Ambassador John Kenneth Galbraith have petitioned the Polish Government "to repudiate unequivocally all anti-Semitism, including that disguised as anti-Zionism."

WEST POINT, N.Y. (WNS) Memorial services are to be held here on June 9 for the late Col. David "Mickey" Marcus with approval of the United States Military Academy, which is to provide three drummers and a bugler to render the taps at the ceremony.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Foreign Minister Abba Eban, in a Knesset speech, voiced concern over the rise to political prominence of the neo-Nazi National Democratic Party in West Germany.

JERUSALEM (WNS) A signature campaign by a number of students against government settlement or annexation of occupied Arab territory triggered a number of minor clashes on the Hebrew University campus when irate opposing groups tried to overturn tables and prevent the petitioners from securing signatures.

COLOGNE (WNS)Anarray of witnesses from the United States identified KurtWieser, principal defendant on trial here on charges of complicity and participation in the brutal liquidation in January 18, 1943 of the ghetto in the Lithuanian city of Grodno, as the man who shot down many Jews in cold blood.

Though the testimony of the witnesses, all of them survivors of the holocuast, differed in details, there was complete uniformity on identifying Wieser as one of the most brutal killers, a Nazi who often delighted in killing his victims with his own hands.

One of the witnesses, Boris Sulkies of New York, told the court he saw Wieser, wearing white gloves, killing two men and hanging a Jewish girl by the name

of Lena Bresska, As the Jewish girl was being led to the noose, he testified, she spat in Wieser's face shouting defiantly "some day you'll pay for this,"

Another witness, Sylvia Kersch, also of New York, described how the defendant fired shots into a synagogue herded with Jews like herring into a barrel, preparatory to their deportation to the death ovens in Auschwitz.

Earlier, Aaron Berman, Lisa Berman and Reuben Loren, all of Chicago, all identified the defendant as the righleader of the massacre. Loren told the court he witnessed the shooting of 300 Jews in groups of 50 at a time, with Wieser directing the slaughter and doing some shooting of his own.
