UNPRECEDENTED TRIP OFF AND ON AGAIN

MOSCOW RABBI ON WAY

NEW YORK (WNS) There was speculation here that the announced visit of Chief Rabbi Yehuda Leib Levin may never materialize as the American Council of Judaism disclosed cancellation of a scheduled public meeting the distinguished rabbi was to address.

The Moscow rabbi was to have come to the United States on June 10 accompanied by Cantor David Stiskin. When the Soviet Embassy broke the news of the impending visit some weeks ago, it indicated the rabbi would be accompanied by a three-man delegation, including two rabbis. Later, a Moscow report said only the rabbi and the cantor would come. When Washington indicated early last week that it had no knowledge of a request for a visa for the rabbi to come to this country, Council leaders said they had no knowledge what was happening but that they had a commitment he would come to New York. A Council spokesman said that "the meeting is expected to take place next week" without however indicating what assurances he had there would

be no further delay or even cancellation.

In Washington, there was speculation that Moscow deliberately chose to postpone the visit for a time more propitious for maximum

publicity. Moscow, according to Washington sources, feels the publicity value of the Chief Rabbi's coming to America would be diminished because of the turmoil in the United States over the Kennedy and the arrest of

Dr. Martin Luther King's killer.

Some circles here familiar with Soviet Affairs are even inclined to the view that the rabbi's visit may either be postponed indefinitely or cancelled altogether.
