GIVE ISRAEL PLANES

WASHINGTON (WNS) A press association report from Jerusalem that Soviet pilots were flying for the Egyptian Air Force was termed here by State Depart-

ment officials as a maneuver to pressure the U.S. into approving the sale to Israel of 50 Phantom jets it is seeking.

According to the report from Jerusalem, said to be based on alleged information from Israeli intelligence sources, the Soviet Union has poured \$1.5 billion worth of arms into Egypt and was providing Egypt with as many as 100 pilots who are flying extensive air patrols throughout the Middle East. The plane ratio between Israel and Egypt now, the report said, is four to one as against a ratio of one to three before the Six Day War. The officials of the State Department insisted on anonymity.
