

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) A documentary film showing the extent to which Jewish religious shrines and institutions were desecrated in East Jerusalem during the nineteen years it was under the occupation of Jordan, has been released by the Ministry of Religious Affairs for showing in the nation's schools and community centers.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A suggestion that the U.S. sponsor a new resolution on the Middle East in the United Nations Security Council, if its previous resolution of November 22, 1967 proves inadequate to initiate Arab-Israel negotiations, was made on the floor of the Senate by Senator Jacob K. Javits, New York Republican.

TEL AVIV (WNS) War-torn and starving Aiafra, the besieged eastern province of Nigeria, has received an Israeli gift of five tons of food and medical supplies.

LONDON (WNS) Failure to detect two Israeli jet fighters that allegedly reached the home of President Nassar has led to the court martialing the twenty Egyptian air force officers, according to information reaching from Cairo.

BONN (WNS) West Germany will give Israel a loan of \$35 million. The agreement, to be signed by Germany and Israeli ambassador Asher Ben Nathan, ended after a period of negotiations that were described as most difficult.

ROME (WNS) Pope Paul VI has received Israeli Ambassador Ehud Avriel in a half hour farewell audience. The departing Israeli Ambassador presented the Pope with a gift of three antique oil lamps from the first, fourth and eighth centuries of the Common Era.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Belief that Egypt's refusal to give the green light has balked Jordan from making a bid for direct peace talks with Israel was voiced here by informed circles on the basis of an analysis of the recent talks held in The Hague between Foreign Minister Abba Eban and UN Special peace envoy Dr. Gunnar V. Jarring.

BONN (WNS) Sharp membership increases were claimed by the neo-Nazi National Democratic Party in the face of Claims by the Ministry of the Interior that losses and gains balanced each other and hence there were no party gains. The neo-nazis said the party now has a membership of 48,000, some 5,000 of them new recruits who became members this year.

BUENOS AIRES (WNS) A resolution condemning the Soviet Union for its anti-Israel policies and its denial of equal right to the Jewish minority in the country was adopted here at the annual meeting of DAIA, central representative body of Argentine Jewry.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Responses to questionnaires sent to his constituents by Representative Ogden Reid, New York Republican, show that a substantial majority of New Yorkers share Israel's views on some of the major aspects of the Middle East problem.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A concurrent resolution calling on the West German Government to extend the statute of limitations for prosecuting Nazi war criminals was introduced in the House by Rep. William Broomfield, Michigan Republican who is a member of the House Foreign Affairs Committee.

LONDON (WNS) The synagogue in Latin America is "the least important institution in Jewish life in this part of the world," it was asserted here at the biennial convention of the World Council of Synagogues by Rabbi Marshall Meyer of Buenos Aires.

NEW YORK CITY -- Thirty-three American Youngsters between the ages of fourteen and sixteen left for Israel to start a year of high school study in Israel as a part of the America - Israel Secondary School Program of the Department of Education and Culture of the Jewish Agency for Israel. Twenty-eight of them are enrolled for second year high school studies and five for third year studies.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Belief that he had "every reason to believe that the United States Government will give its blessings to any talks that might be held between Israel and the Arabs and would not try to intervene in the discussions" was voiced here by Foreign Minister Abba Eban, who simultaneously asserted that Israel stood by its proposal for a regional meeting on the refugee problem with the view of developing a five-year plan for refugee aid.

GENEVA (WNS) The Conference of Jewish Organizations, concluding its three-day conference, adopted a resolution urging UN Secretary-General U Thant to insist that when the UN names an investigator to study the situation of civilians in the Middle East he be given unrestricted authority and an opportunity to visit Jewish communities and imprisoned Jews in the Arab countries.

SANTIAGO de CHILE (WNS) A speeding car last Sunday hurled Molotov cocktail at a Jewish school causing a fire and damaging windows. The police is conducting an investigation.
