LONDON (WNS) Growing friction between Egyptians and Russian instructors and advisors in military and industrial establishments was disclosed here by the Telegraph in a report by its correspondent in Beirut, Lebanon.

The Egyptians were said to resent efforts by the Russians to indoctrinate them with communism and Soviet Failure to supply Egypt with sufficient modern offensive weapons. According to the report, Egypt has received from Russia all the military equipment it is now capable of handling.

CZECK AGAIN

LONDON (WNS) A declaration denouncing anti-Semitism as a barbaric manifestation that is in conflict with the civilized traditions of their country was

issued by the scientific council of Charles University in Prague, Czechoslovakia.

Triggering the statement was a recent anti-Semitic attack on Dr. Eduard Goldstuecker, university vice rector, whose life had been threatened after publication by a communist newspaper in Prague of an anonymous letter calling him "a disgusting Jew" and a "Zionist hyena." An important figure in his nation's liberalization movement, Dr. Goldstuecker is chairman of the Czech Writers Union.

POLL THE POLES

LONDON (WNS) There apparently is growing awareness in government circles and the communist party structure in Poland that the recent anti-Zionist drive, during which many Jews were purged from government and other posts, was in effect an anti-Semitic manifestation

whose repercussions have still not been fully measured.

This, in the opinion of informed sources here, is the meaning of the dialogue on the issue at a meeting in Warsaw of the Central Committee of the Polish Communist Party.

PAL JORDAN

JERUSALEM (WNS) Premier Levi Eshkol, in an interview on Radio Israel, declared that Jordan remains Israel's security border.

At the same time the Premier drew a distinction between political border security and the cease fire line. When boundaries between Israel and her neighbors are finally drawn up,

he said, account must be taken of Israel's historic right to the land of Israel.

BULLETS FOR PEACE

JERUSALEM (WNS) George Ball, newly appointed U. S. Ambassador to the United Nations, conferred here with Premier Levi Eshkol and Foreign Minister Abba Eban.

While talks were on about peace and settlement, a series of incidents took place along the Jordan River in which four Arab saboteurs were killed and three Israeli soldiers wounded. Another clash, with a group of raiders, took the lives of two Arab infiltrators. There were no Israeli casualties.
