

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

**NEW YORK (WNS)** Subtle anti-Semitism is lurking behind the opposition that has been building up in the Senate against confirming Justice Abe Fortas as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, it was charged here by Paul O'Dwyer, Democratic candidate for the Senate.

**STARLIGHT PARK, PENN. (WNS)** The 23rd international convention here by B'nai B'rith Young Adults, in a resolution backing Negro efforts to introduce Afro-American studies in the schools, said they favored introduction of Hebrew courses in schools with a sizeable body of Jewish students.

**WASHINGTON (WNS)** - The Senate has approved a foreign aid bill which provides for the sale of supersonic jets to Israel. Under the bill, sale of the jets is to finally rest in the discretion of the President.

**MIAMI BEACH (WNS)** - Inclusion of the plank in Republican Party platform denouncing the anti-Jewish policies in the Soviet Union and other communistic countries is urged hereby Rep. Edward J. Derwinski, Illinois Republican, who is a member of the House Foreign Affairs Committee.

**NEW YORK:** - The American Jewish Committee has joined with the United Methodist Church, the National Council of Churches, and the National Catholic Office for Radio and Television, in the sponsorship of "Night Call", the new national radio call-in-program, it was announced by Dr. Harry Spencer, General Secretary of the Television, Radio and Film Commission of the United Methodist Church.

**PHILADELPHIA:** - The Philadelphia Chapter of the American Jewish Committee has organized an advisory service to assist community, church, and other groups to initiate and develop housing projects of all kinds in the Philadelphia area.

**BONN (WNS)** Algeria faces a boycott by international trade unionists if it does not release the hijacked Israeli plane, its crew and a number of Israeli male passengers. This development emerged when the International Transport Federation voted unanimously to align itself on the issue with the Maritime Committee of the American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations in the United States.

**TEL AVIV (WNS)** - High praise for the Jewish National Fund has been voiced by Premier Levi Eshkol in a letter to former Ambassador Jacob Tsur, president of Keren Kayemeth.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** - Algeria's reportedly correct treatment of the crew and still detained passengers of the hijacked Israeli plane has bolstered the hope of this country of their early return. This, Foreign Minister Abba Eban said, is a basis for hope that principles of international law and morality would be applied by Algeria in solving the problem by immediate release of the plane and the men.

**TEL AVIV (WNS)** - The occurrence of 31 incidents last week along the Israeli-Jordanian cease-fire line has triggered belief in security circles here that the development might presage more intensified anti-Israel activity. In those incidents, 3 Israelis were killed and 15 injured, while 10 of the saboteurs were killed and one captured. Some of the Jordanians who were captured in recent weeks were reported to have said that the trespassing terrorists had the cooperation of Jordan.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** - Apparently authentic rumors to the effect that the Jewish State Theater in Poland will no longer be independent Jewish. Stte - supported cultural institution circulated here in informed circles familiar with the situation in Poland.

a member of the Supreme Court, and it is ridiculous to attack his nomination on the grounds that President Johnson is now a "lame duck" president and nothing should be done until after election."

Fike said he believes the President's nomination of Fortas was "made in conformity with the Constitution" and that, a filibuster would not be justified.

The Lieut. Gov., a candidate for the Republican no-

mination for the U. S. Senate, stated he was in agreement with the Republican Party national platform plank supporting Israel, but added with sincerity, "It still could have been worded in much stronger and more forceful language."

deniable" fact that Israel is facing a growing menace, the United States must provide her with countervailing help such as "supersonic fighters as necessary for those purposes."

This was the position taken by the Republican Party at its convention here in its platform plank on foreign

affairs.  
At the same time the platform pledged the Republican Party to bring an end to the arms race "through international agreement and the stationing of peace-table talks among adversarities." This provision was written in against the background of a charge that the Soviet Union persisted "in building up an imbalance of military forces in this region."

A platform highlight was condemnation, for the first time, of the "continuing anti-Semitic actions by Soviet Russia. "The plank also condemned the Soviet Union for "its efforts to eradicate all religions, and its oppression of minorities."

**BONN (WNS)** - West German Foreign Ministry sources said a one-time official in the Nazi Foreign Ministry, who was recalled from a Lisbon post over charges he had been involved in Nazi war crimes, would return to his post and then take his annual holiday. The sources did not indicate what the investigation of Herbert Mueller-Roschach's Nazi past had disclosed.
