

THERE WILL BE RECOURSE

JERUSALEM (WNS) Israel will find an answer to all acts of Arab aggression and the enemy will be made to pay the price for its intransigence, Premier Levi Eshkol declared here in an address at a meeting of an Histadrut campaign study mission from the United States.

Speaking against the background of Israel's aerial attack on El Fatah sabotage bases in the town of Salt some fifteen miles west of the Jordanian capital of Amman, the Israeli Premier warned that, in view of the burgeoning acts of aggression being committed against Israel, it was the world's responsibility to make it impossible for aggressors to get away with murder. Israel, he told the gathering, cannot shun its responsibility to safeguard life, liberty and property.

Referring to the obvious refusal of Algeria to move toward the release of the hijacked Israeli plane, its crew and seven or nine male Israeli passengers, Mr. Eshkol said there wasn't the "slightest excuse for harboring stolen goods and kidnapping people."

The action against the terrorist bases in Jordan was

taken by units of the Israel air force whose planes bombed the site for about three hours and returned safely after completing the mission. The action against Jordan was taken because of virtually incessant terrorist attacks on Israel since mid-June, when more than 100 incidents were reported.

As the flying mission was returning to its base, Jordanian units opened tank fire on Israeli forces near the Allenby Bridge, precipitating an artillery duel that lasted more than two hours.

The sabotage camps near Salt were believed to have housed about 400 saboteurs.

Despite the aerial attack, Arab saboteurs continued attacking in the Beisan Valley where Jordanians fired two bazooka shells at Israeli forces.

Meanwhile it has been learned that the aerial attack on Jordan was carried out only after a long series of warnings to Amman, both directly and indirectly. The most recent was a statement by Foreign Minister Abba Eban warning that activity against Israel along the Jordanian border would not remain one-sided.

CRUCIAL ROLE

WASHINGTON -- The "crucial role" of the United States in deterring threats of Soviet armed intervention in the unsettled Middle East was emphasized by B'nai B'rith in a twentieth anniversary message to President Zalman Shazar of Israel.

Dr. William A. Wexler, president of B'nai B'rith, in a cable congratulating Israel on the anniversary, called the "disruptive diplomacy" of the Soviet Union in arming and encouraging Arab terrorists and extremists "the explosive danger in the Middle East."
