"There must be equity in law, therefore, while the law clearly states that any landlord can have a three-day summary eviction without a hearing in court, there is nothing in the law that states a hearing cannot be held, therefore, I feel it is the duty of the Justice Court to maintain such equity and provide hearings, where requested, on any eviction," "Pat Finnegan, candidate for Justice of the Peace, in the Las Vegas Township, stated today.

Paul Price, candidate for County Commissioner, today called for strong state legislation to prevent what he termed "Conflict of Interest Deals" involving public officials.

"It is imperative we enact a strong statute to protect the people from illegal, immoral and unethical machinations by public of-ficials," he said, "The present statue falls far short of setting standards of public morality one expects from persons entrusted with these elected or appointed offices."

Price's demand was sparked by the disclosure that Clark County Commissioners are considering purchase of a medical building at a cost estimated three times greater than the price one year ago.

Principals who have offered the property to the commission are City Planning Commissioner Don Gilday, a Real Estate Broker, and County Planning Commissioner Ken Johann, also a broker.

The same building reportedly was for sale one year ago at a price estimated at both \$750,000 and \$1,600,-000, depending on the source of information.
