helpful it is if we can give ourselves the necessary summons to the court of our own judgment, before some calamity occurs.

There are hundreds of ways to drive home the value of the holiday purgation. Let me offer a trio of words which may set up mental chain reactions which will perhaps suggest procedures for reflective atonement.

My first word is solve. If the holidays do nothing more than pin us down to a strong effort to solve our dilemmas they will serve a splendid purpose. As the years race by we leave many decisions in the air. We find all kinds of ruses to evade the need through our aims in life and our relations with members of our family. Can we concentrate on getting rid of that pernicious habit of procrastination to which we have become prey? Can we determine what should be our attitude towards our faith, towards our relatives, our community and world? Be still, my soul, counsels Judaism, and stop long enough once and for all to solve some of these quandaries.

The other holiday word is akin to solve -- it's dissolve. Some of our problems cry out for solution; some of our attitudes and traits require dissolution. We would be a lot more satisfied, we would be much more useful if we

could, through a burst of holiday - augmented energy throw off an eliminate tendencies which are harmful and deleterious.

Both solve and dissolve are words related to the kindred term, resolve. It is now deemed almost fuddy-duddy to talk about New Year resolutions. They are the object of derision rather than decision. But in many respects a return to tested practices is urgently needed in this world of ours. One cartoonist shows an agitator with a placard demanding "The right to prevent speech," and labels it the New Politics. If the new politics or the mod approach to decency add up to the disregard of vital values we should all plead guilty of adhering to "old-fashioned" virtues. Something old is not necessarily antiquated.

So let us not hesitate to make certain resolves and let us carry out these intentions with unwavering resoluteness. Each of us knows best what would be most desirable in the fashioning of a better self. Under the impressive impact of our holiday liturgy let us determine to cease dilly-dallying and shilly - shallying and take stock of what we need for our moral improvement.

Yes, if we can launch a personal voyage into inner space and seek solutions, dissolutions and resolutions, we will enter 5729 refreshingly cleansed.
