CHICAGO (WNS) A plank on the Middle East, calling on the United States to provide Israel with "essential militery equipment needed for her defense," was approved at the Democratic national convention here last week, thus paralleling in most respects that adopted by the Republican convention in Miami Beach and placing both major political parties squarely in postures of friendship for Israel and its needs.

The Democrats favored "most advanced" types of combat aircraft for Israel as long as it "is threatened by hostile and well-armed neighbors." The plant calls the Middle East region a "powder keg" that must be prevented from blowing up if there is to be no recurrence of war in the area.

Referring to the Soviet rearming of the Arab states and the deployment of the Soviet fleet in the Mediterranean, the Democrats went on record to the effect that "lasting peace in the Middle East depends upon agreed and secured frontiers, respect for the territorial integrity of all the states, the guaranteed right in innocent passage through all international waterways, a humane settlement of the

POLISH BIAS

LONDON (WNS) The open anti-Jewish and anti-Zionist drive in Poland has been replaced by a quiet campaign -----

aimed at systematically dislodging Jews from jobs, homes, schools, and government posts, according to reports reaching here from reliable sources in Warsaw. In government the policy

for the present is to retain Jews in posts where they are irreplaceable but to quietly replace them as soon as qualified non - Jewish Poles can be found. Also, Jews who formerly held high positions in the fields of education and technology are being offered menial jobs and parents of Jewish school children who were discharged before the end of the term have been told to find new schools. The official excuse is overcrowding, even for those of the Jewish children with high academic records. Many Jews have been forced to leave their apartments because of loss of jobs, particularly in those instances where the flat went with the iob.

EGYPT SMOKESCREEN

FRIDAY, SEPT. 6, 1968 Tekoah of Israel, reacting to recent press reports that Egyptian diplomats were probing for a new formula that would prove satisfactory to Israel in settling the differences between those two countries, termed the socalled new peace offensive another in the many meaningless smokescreens "behind which Cairo hides its continued refusal to make peace with Israel and its growing intransigence."

Mr. Tekoah recalled the belligerent statements made by President Nasser in July, declaring that the current crop of peace rumors from Cairo were added examples of "progaganda games of words." Triggering the Tekoah statement was a report in the New York Times that Egyptian diplomats were pushing a formula under which Israel's insistence on direct talks and recognition of its sovereignty would be circumvented by a "declaration of peace" to be underwritten by the U N Security Council.
