

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

LONDON (WSN) Trafim Kitchko, the notorious Ukrainian anti-Semite who once authored the Streicher-like book "Judaism Without Embellishments," is at it again, according to reliable reports reaching Jewish sources here. He is now planning a new book called, "Judaism and Zionism," a condemnation of Judaic ideology which, he says, "teaches Jews how to hate people of their faiths, and even exterminate them."

NEW YORK - An emergency appropriation of \$100,000 to provide assistance for Czech Jewish refugee in Vienna has been made by the Joint Distribution Committee, major American agency aiding needy Jews overseas, it was announced by Samuel L. Haber, JDC Executive Vice-Chairman, who reported that from August 21, date of the Soviet occupation of Czechoslovakia, through September 4th 780 refugees had applied to the JDC office in Vienna for assistance.

Award winning political scientist, Dr. William C. Gerberding of UCLA will set the keynote for the ADL - B'nai B'rith Weekend Institute, which will be held at the El Mirador Hotel, Palm Springs, California beginning Friday, October 4.

NEW YORK, Ernst Benda, West German Minister of the Interior, told Arthur J. Goldberg and a delegation from the American Jewish Committee that he could not definitely predict a further extension of the Statute of Limitations for Nazi murderers.

LOS ANGELES: The Jewish War Veterans' National policy decision on the Fortas appointment was reported by Joseph Solomonow of Beverly Hills to the California Department Policy Committee. It expressed concern over the "disgraceful smear campaign against Justice Fortas," Solomonow expressed the view that "much of the opposition comes from the same people who have opposed the Supreme Court decisions these past number of years because they do not like, understand, or accept the role of the Supreme Court in our Constitutional form of government."

NEW YORK (WSN) A new wave of hooliganism has swept the Williamsburg section of Brooklyn, terrorizing Jewish pedestrians and shop keepers throughout the hours of the day and night, it was disclosed in a recent issue of The Day-Jewish Journal, Yiddish daily.

NEW YORK (WSN) False and highly inflated Arab refugee population figures, stemming from the failure of UNRWA officials and Arab families to report deaths, spurious registrations and black market ration cards, have duped the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine out of millions of dollars coming from American tax payers, it was charged in the current issue of Look magazine by Ira Hirschman, a specialist in refugee affairs.

TEL AVIV (WSN) Most Israelis - to be exact, three quarters of them - believe that the United States will come to the aid of their country in crisis, and two-thirds of all the dwellers in the land believe that the United States yields the greatest cultural influence on Israel, according to a recent survey in Davar, an Histadrut organ.

CINCINNATI (WSN) Establishment of a Barry Goldwater Research Fund at the American Jewish Archives by some Jewish friends of the former U.S. Senator from Arizona was disclosed here in an announcement which said the fund would be used to buy or copy documents, letters, diaries and other archival material related to Jewish men and women and the roles they played in building the American West.

WASHINGTON (WSN) When the 387 all-day Hebrew schools in the United States and Canada open their doors this fall they will show an enrollment of more than 70,000 pupils.

JOHANNESBURG (WSN) An assertion by the newly appointed Minister of Police S. Lourens Muller that Jewish students led and instigated recent demonstrations elicited the charge that he was "a blatant anti-Semite." The demonstration in question protested the ouster of a black lecturer from Capetown University.

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WSN) An array of Arab spokesmen charged here that Israel was to blame for the failure of the welfare programs.

LONDON (WSN) Now that the inland Polish blasts against Zionism have somewhat abated, Polish newspapers have reverted to the practice by picking up the anti-Zionist threat in Czechoslovakia.

JERUSALEM (WSN) Rabbi Bezalel Zolti, a member of the high rabbinic court, has ruled that, under Halachic law, Israel need not return the land it captured from its enemies in last year's Six Day War.
