

### JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS) Because of the recent purging of Jews from scientific posts, atomic research in Poland has received a serious setback, according to reports reaching here.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Arabs in the West Bank are being urged by underground propagandists not to pay taxes.

WASHINGTON (WNS) The American-Israel Public Affairs Committee announced that the platform committees of the Republican and Democratic parties will be asked to include in their platforms' planks on the Middle East a provision for the need of direct peace talks between Israel and the Arab states and for providing Israel with "supersonic planes and any other military equipment necessary to enable her to deter threatened aggression."

JERUSALEM (WNS) A warning that Israel will not tolerate ~~terrorist gangs and~~ saboteurs was sounded by Minister of Defense Moshe Dayan at a meeting with Arab officials in the Hebron area, where he said Israel was tightening security measures against the marauders.

PARIS (WNS) President de Gaulle was quoted here by a French journalist, Jean Raymond Tournoux, as having said even though he had been "offended, insulted and calumniated" for the pro-Arab policies of his government in the aftermath of the Six Day War he was still a "a friend of Israel."

BONN (WNS) Neo-Nazism "is not our business" and "we have nothing to do with it," it was declared here by Adolf von Thadden, head of the right-wing National Democratic Party which has been accused of being a neo-Nazi political movement.

NEW YORK (WNS) Although both presidential candidates stand committed to supplying Israel with Phantom jets, "only President Johnson can make such a decision in the immediate future," it was declared here by Rabbi Herschel Shacter, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations.

WASHINGTON (WNS) There is "absolutely no anti-Semitism" involved in the developing Senate opposition to the nomination of Abe Fortas as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, according to Senate majority leader Mike Mansfield, Montana Democrat.

TEL AVIV (WNS) For the third time in two days, Jordanian terrorists, entrenched in the village of Bakoura hurled bazooka and machine gun fire on an Israeli armored patrol near Ashdod Yaakov in the northern area of the Beisan Valley.
