The past year has been one of unusual turbulence, We enter the New Year, 5729, with the hope that it will bring with it peace and harmony among all peoples of the world.



This involves an many-faceted program: the encouragement and development of a much needed western aliyah; the furtherance of a program of education, interpretation and understanding of Israel's problems in the world of nations; and




