

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

NEW YORK -- "Resistance and Redemption" is the theme of the annual celebration of Jewish Book Month from November 15 to December 15 in commemoration of the 25th anniversary of the ghetto uprisings.

ATLANTA, - Louis G. Cowan, a leading figure in the communications field, has been chosen to direct the organization of the William E. Wiener Oral History Library of the American Jewish Committee.

ATLANTA, - The executive head of the American Jewish Committee Bertram H. Gold, said that the conflict between young and old, the growing fears by Jews of Negro militancy, and the increasing polarization of our society with the use of direct confrontations as a major weapon of social change were among matters of greatest current concern to the American Jewish community.

NEW YORK: - John W. Gardner, chairman of the Urban Coalition, and David Aronow of New York, industrialist and philanthropist, have been named the 1968 winners of the Stephen S. Wise Award of the American Jewish Congress.

NEW YORK, - Samuel Neaman, head of the far-ranging retailing concern, McCrory Corporation, was honored in recognition of his humanitarian activities and his World War II service, in which he rose from private to major in the British Eighth Army. Not only did the Jewish War Veterans, U.S. A. award him their Gold Medal of Merit at a dinner attended by more than 800 persons, but Mr. Neaman's wartime sergeant major, Sgt. Asher Braker, came from Israel to salute his former commander.

NEW YORK (LNS) - "High scholastic ability should not be the sole criteria for considering the Jewish education of our children," the Lubavitcher Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, declared here in a public address. "Many educators who seek to get the best results by giving preference to the better qualified student neglect too often the less proficient.

NEW YORK, - Olcott D. Smith, Chairman of Aetna Life & Casualty, received the AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE 1968 Human Relations Award.

PARIS (WNS) -- King Hussein of Jordan has denied that any contact has taken place or is taking place between his country and Israel.

PARIS (WNS) -- The manufacturer of the Mirage jet fighter which is the backbone of Israel's Air force has declared that Israel would get the 50 paid-for-Mirage-V jets embargoed in France if the nation was ever in danger.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- The Soviet Press has sharply attacked Gen. Moshe Dayan, Israel's Defense Minister, for a speech in which he warned that Israel must strengthen its position in the occupied Arab territories. The press attacks also included a denunciation of Israeli Foreign Minister Abba Eban's peace proposals presented to the United Nations and an indictment of the United States for its "decision to sell" 50 Phantom jet fighter-bombers to Israel.

BONN (WNS) -- The reputedly neo-Nazi National Democratic Party (NPD) appeared to have sustained setbacks in local elections held in three German states, winning about 5.2 percent of the vote. This was far short of the party's expectation.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- An American Jewish Committee official has denied that anti-Semitism is a factor in the New York City school strike.

MIAMI (WNS) -- Jordanian pilots and ground crewmen being trained at the Homestead Air Force near here to operate and maintain F-104 jet fighters have been buying small arms in Miami gunships to take back to Jordan.

ROME (WNS) -- President Giuseppe Saragat of Italy told a delegation of Jews observing the 25th anniversary of the deportation of the Jews of Rome by the Nazis that every civilized person must harbor a sense of guilt over the treatment of the Jews of Europe during the years of Nazi rule.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israeli Prime minister Levi Eshkol expects to see President JOHNSON AND President-elect when he makes a visit to the United states in December.

drawing up a sales contract. Sale of the Phantoms would mark a significant new U. S. involvement in Israel's security requirements, an official said, and it was reasonable to seek some "quid pro quo." The unspecified arrangement could involve Israeli concessions on direct talks with the Arabs; signing of the nuclear non-proliferation treaty; restraint on reprisal raids against Jordan; or other points important to the State Department.

During the White House meeting, Mr. Eban said he gave President Johnson "a detailed account of our efforts to explore avenues to peace at the United Nations including utilization of con-

tacts with Ambassador (Gunnar V) Jarring." He said he told the President it was "necessary not only to explore peace but to foreclose the prospect of war."

The meeting with Mr. Johnson, Mr. Eban said, indicated to him a continuity of "solid friendship and sympathy" linking the United States and Israel. Both meetings, he said, involved discussion on the jet sale and other topics, including the prospects of regional peace.

Mr. Eban also said "we take the President's statement (on the jet sale) very seriously" and voiced the hope that negotiations would lead to fulfillment of Israel's needs. He said the negotiations were similar to the talks two years ago which lead to Israel's purchase of subsonic Skyhawk planes.
