interest to have peace there and that we do care very much about peace there.

That region holds much danger to world peace. I would take the initiative to encourage mutual cooperation between Israel and the arabs. I would encourage multi lateral talks to search for means to resolve and stabilize the boundaries there and to provide for the free use of water and land routes. I would advocate binding non aggression agreements. But I repeat, an imbalance of military force is dangerous there. If Russia continues to arm the arabs to such an extent as to pose a threat to Israel then we would support her with the same level of strength.

Yes, then I, as President, would assure that Israel is kept at a commensurate level of strength. As I said we must provide adequate arms and equipment to maintain a balance of force in the Mideast.

Q: How do you stand on aid to Israel? Would you give those Phantom Jets?

A: Yes, whatever it takes to keep the military balance there; phantoms, submarines, or M-16 rifles...whatever the military folks say it takes, I would give...whatever it takes to keep a balance...then I'm for that. A balance of military force would be the first priority.

As I said, if the Russians continue to arm the Arabs, then we have to do what is necessary to keep a military balance there. I hope we can even talk ourselves with the Arabs and say.

'Look, we are not against you...folks...but, let's just see if we can't sit down and work out a peaceful solution and settlement with you and the Israelis once and for all... so you and your children and grandchildren can live in peace from now on, and not worry about being killed in a war. It is in the interest -- in the long run -- of both sides and in the interest of world peace, to have lasting peace there. I would do my utmost to try to go down in history as one of those who helped settle the Mideast conflict once and for all....

Q: Do you see a relationship between the Mideast and Vietnam?

A: They are both very explosive and that's the reason I hope we can do what is necessary to talk to both sides to coming to a settlement in the Mideast and conclude the matter in Vietnam.

RICHARD NIXON

NEW YORK. - Richard M. Nixon believes preventive diplomacy is necessary for the Soviet Union to understand that the U. S. will not tolerate any Soviet takeover of the Middle East or the destruction of Israel.

The Republican candidate for President make the statement in a meeting here with the conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, whose 22 constituent bodies represent the overwhelming majority of U. S. Jews.

Rabbi Herschel Schacter of New York, chairman of the conference, said after the hour-long meeting that the members of the key Jewish leadership group were "impressed" by Mr. Nixon's "firm grasp of the problems of international concern to the American Jewish community" -- chief among them peace in the Middle East, the security of Israel and the safety of Jews in the Soviet bloc.

Rabbi Schacter said Mr. Nixon had "made clear his belief that it was in the vital interest of the United States and the cause of world peace that Israel possess the superiority in military strength necessary to deter Arab aggression." The American Jewish leader said Mr. Nixon had described the intentions of Israel's Arab neighbors as "seeking vengeance against Israel while Israel sought only to defend its own independence."

According to Rabbi Schacter, the Republican nominee also stated his opposition to any kind of imposed peace settlement in the Middle East that would be guaranteed by the major powers including Soviet Russia, rather than one that was arrived at by the parties to the dispute. No Russian-guaranteed peace will work and the whole world knows it since the invasion of Czechoslovakia. Mr. Nixon was reported to have told the Presidents Conference.

The former Vice President also said it was important to create world opinion and document the facts of Soviet anti-Semitism, Rabbi Schacter reported. Mr. Nixon, he said, declared that the deep concern of the American people for the cultural and religious freedom of Soviet Jews should be firmly communicated on many levels to the leaders of the Soviet government.
