Murray Kachad New Trustee At S.N.M.H.

Board of County Commissioners yesterday named pharmacist Murray Kachad to replace Harry Reid on the Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital Board of Trustees.

Reid submitted his resignation from the board, of which he was chairman, on his election to an Assembly District 4 seat. He served as board chairman since early last January when Administrator Jack Staggs quit along with former chairman Fred Morledge and board member Ray Collins.

County commissioners yesterday accepted Reid's resignation, with Commissioners Darwin Lamb, Lou La Porta and Bill

Reid are voting for Kachad, who had campaigned before for a hospital board seat.

The hospital board was scheduled to meet last night when it was expected to consider naming a new chairman.

Reid had high praise for the "hospital as a county institution." He indicated he could better represent Clark County and work in the same direction as a member of the Legislature.

Kachad, a Las Vegas pharmacist since 1954 was founder and first chairman of the Jaycee children's zoo at Tule Springs, charter member of the Nevada Public Health Association, and past board member of the Clark County Chapter American Cancer Society.

He is a Mason, Shriner and member of the American Legion.
