

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Lebanon still has not recovered from the Israeli reprisal raid on Beirut International Airport. Students have temporarily closed the nation's four universities and have demanded mandatory military training, a proposal supported by many Government and religious leaders.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- A petition containing 10,000 signatures and a demand that the Warsaw regime end its harassment of Polish Jews, especially the semi-secret trials of Polish Jewish students, has been submitted to United Nations Secretary General U Thant.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The sale of Israel Bonds in the New York metropolitan area in 1968 totaled \$25,400,000, the greatest sales figure in the history of the New York campaign except for 1967, the Six-Day War year.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The lecture bureau of the National Jewish Welfare Board is sponsoring a tour of the United States and Canada in January and February by Ida Kaminska, the former director and star of Poland's Yiddish State Theatre.

WASHINGTON -- The American Jewish Congress announced its support of proposed regulations that would permit welfare recipients to become eligible for Federal financial and medical aid on their own declaration, without investigation.

TEL AVIV: - The Israel Government's inability to increase its budgetary allocations for social services in the face of the country's growing social welfare needs, will place "a heavier burden than ever before" on Malben, the Joint Distribution Committee's welfare program in Israel, Mr. Harold Trobe, JDC/Malben Director-General declared in Tel Aviv.

JERUSALEM (WSN) -- Jerusalem will host the Fourth International Bible Quiz on March 12 in its Convention Hall. More than 15 nations have indicated they will send participants.

NEW YORK (WSN) -- The Rabbinical Council of America has formed the first international agency of Orthodox rabbis to bind together the relations of Jewish communities, provide American support for the "decimated European Jewish Communities," and help meet the lack of rabbis in nations.

TEL AVIV (WSN) -- Former Prime Minister David Ben-Gurion has informed the Knesset (Parliament) that he regards himself as a one-man faction which he calls Rafi.

Rafi. He is also said to be planning to run in this year's national elections.

HAIFA (WSN) -- Dr. Elli Fraiser head of Hafia's Rumbam Hospital neurological surgery department, said he had successfully treated a patient with Parkinson's Disease, a generally incurable ailment that affects the brain cells and causes palsy.

LOS ANGELES (WSN) -- Israel's retaliatory actions against Arab concerns over the urban critics in America will be analyzed in two reports to be given by Human H. Haves, 6th Regional Executive Director of the Jewish War Veterans, U.S.A., to the California Executive Committee meeting at the Melody Ranch, Palm Springs, California the weekend of January 10-12, 1969

He said the UN resolution on November 1967, calling for an Israeli withdrawal and other actions was "not self-executing" as the Arabs had contended. In addition, he said Israel had indicated

it would "accept and implement that resolution in accordance with the agreements to be reached."

Arab states had accused Israel of refusing to state explicitly her acceptance of the resolution, claiming they cannot proceed with negotiations until Israel does so.
