attributed to Prime Minister Levi Eshkol stating that Jerusalem was not interested in retaining heavily populated West Bank centers such as Nablus and Jenin indicate a trend among some members of the Government to favor withdrawal from the new territories except for East Jerusalem, the Golan Heights, Gaza and Sharm-El-Shiekh.

Mr. Eshkol, Deputy Prime Minister Yigal Allon, Foreign Minister Abba Eban and Defense Minister Moshe Dayan have all indicated their belief in statements in the past that Israel would withdraw from most occupied Arab territories, holding on to those areas necessary for defense such as the Golan Heights, Gaza and Sharm-el-Shiekh and Jerusalem, which no Israeli Government could possibly allow to be divided again.

Mr. Eshkol's remarks, carried in Newsweek Magazine, caused a brief but intense political crisis for the

JEWS RELEASED FROM PRISON

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Iraq has reportedly released about 21 to 27 Jews from prison, according to diplomatic reports that have reached Israel.

Israeli officials were pleased at the news if it they believe is accurate. But they noted that the men released were originally arrested at the time of the Six-Day War and were not among those whom the Baghdad Government has charged with being spies.

No word has been received about further trials of Jews. The Iraq Government has announced that a number of men are not being tried on spy charges but that all defendants are Moslems. Western newsmen reported from Baghdad.

Israel officials noted that the release of the Jews indicated that the Iraq Government is not insensitive to world public opinion and pressure. They do not intervene on behalf of the Israeli Jewish Community with the view to having the 2,000 Jews there allowed to leave the country. A number of Western nations have indicated they will allow the Iraqi Jews to settle in their country.

Some Arab and East European newspapers have quietly attacked the public hangings. They noted that the mass executions and the festivities that followed only harmed the Arab image in the eyes of the world.
