formation supplied by Mr. Eshkol during a two-hour interview.

But the four-member Free Center faction in the Knesset (Parliament) seized on the remarks and introduced a motion of no confidence in the Government. This raised the possibility that the Gahal alignment which favors retaining all the new territories, would withdraw from the "national unity" Cabinet. The Free Center members broke away from Herut several years ago. Herut, together with the Liberal Party, make up Gahal.

Gahal ministers met with Government leaders and decided not to support the no-confidence motion. Other members of the Government took a similar position and the motion was defeated 74-5 with seven abstentions.

Mr. Eshkol had requested the Newsweek interview to answer a magazine interview with Egyptian President Gamal Abdel Nasser, in which the Arab leader proposes a peace plan based on Israeli withdrawal from the occupied lands.

No Government source has denied that Mr. Eshkol made the withdrawal remarks attributed to him in off the record conversation with the Newsweek editor. He has expressed his views in the past without hitherto explicitly mentioning specific areas.
