Dinah Shore announces the coming marriage of her daughter, Melissa, 20, to young actor David Lee Burk, on March 16 in Dinah's Beverly Hills home. Burk hails from Scottsdale, Arizona, and Chester, Pa. He's a graduate of the N. Y. School of Finance but feels that if he scores with an acting career the money will compensate for all he learned about finance.

Dinah winds up her appearance at the Las Vegas Sands Hotel, then returns to Beverly Hills to prepare for the wedding. That done, she'll start rehearsals for her NBC-TV special for viewing in April in her once-famous time slot on Sunday night at 9 p.m. Dinah's guests will be Lucille Ball, Rowan and Martin, Diana Ross and the Supremes.

After 549 shows for Chevy Chase in the 9 p.m. timeslot, Dinah called a halt to her NBC-TV activities on June 25, 1961. Her son, Jody, who attends military school, wears a mezuzah and feels very Jewish in his religious beliefs. Melissa attended Jewish Sunday School where she was confirmed.

Melissa's and Jody's dad, actor George Montgomery, is making a film in Africa and may not be able to return for the wedding. This will be Melissa's first marriage.

Topol also co-stars in Columbia Pictures' "Before Winter Comes" with David Niven and Anna Karina.
