We ran our finger down to near the bottom of the list and there it was, a horse named Four Jacks. Get it? Jackorama and Four Jacks. We hesitated and mused to ourselves. Could this be an omen?

We unfolded a ten dollar bill from our little watch pocket, mad money we'd kept for emergency only. Bet this for us on the double, we instructed Mrs. Howie, buttoned our trench coat and left. As a matter of fact we forgot all about the incident.

The next evening we received a call. It was from Mrs. Howie. Her first words were: "Did you read the results? I'm going to commit suicide. I'm going to jump out the window."

"Are you a nut, or something," we answered. "What happened?"

It seems Jackorama won the first and paid, like \$87.00, and Four Jacks took the second with a \$44.00 mutual. The daily double was in the vicinity of \$5,800 (for \$2). This meant a \$29,000 return for our ten dollar bet.

There is a promising three-year-old named TELL. TELL is a son of former stakes champion Round Table, out of Nas-Mahal, a Nasrullah mare, known for speed with a great deal of stamina. This is perfect breeding for a three-year-old to go the mile and a quarter, Derby distance.

As a two-year-old TELL won his maiden race by two lengths in 1:10 2/5 (outstanding time for a baby horse) at Hollywood Park. In his next race, in allowance company at Del Mar, Tell bucked his shins, finishing second by seven lengths after being eased up.

His first start this year, on a slow track, Tell ran second, three and a half lengths behind the winner, after breaking slowly, and being forced to make the stretch run from far back. The next race, over a sloppy track at Santa Anita, TELL caught the pace setter in the final few yards and won by a length, going away.

Last Saturday, TELL, an odds -on favorite, finished 27 lengths behind the winner. Jockey Willie Shoemaker had the horse under a strong hold. Possibly, it was the payoff, no TELL ever went for the chalk, but in all probability it was the condition of the track, slow, that accounted for the poor showing.

Trainer Chales Whittingham indicates TELL will go in allowance races until the Santa Anita Derby on March 29. Shoemaker is optimistic about our namesake's chances in that one, which will determine whether or not he goes in the Kentucky Derby on May 3.

TELL is owned by Mrs. Howard B. Keck. Get it, Howard-Howie's?
